<p><b>MyEd BC</b> is the information management system used by the Province of British Columbia to manage student information. Many of you are familiar with the Family Portal, which allows you to view your child’s report card and track their attendance. Students will enter their course requests through MyED BC. Don't forget the MyED BC log in page contains a <b>forgot your password</b> feature that is linked to the email you entered into the system last year.
