Partners36 Scholarships & Bursaries

- These scholarships are made possible through the contribution of individuals, corporations and community service organizations.
- <u>DUE DATE</u>: Completed applications should be submitted to Ms. Crocker <u>NO LATER than</u> <u>Tuesday, April 1st at 3.00 PM</u> (no exceptions will be made).

General Eligibility Requirements

- 1. Applicants must be Canadian citizens or have Permanent Resident status.
- 2. The candidate must be a graduate of the Surrey School District.
- 3. In order to receive the funds the candidate must be registered for a full course load at a post-secondary institution. This would be whatever is considered a full course load at the institution concerned, however, the committee may give special consideration to candidates whose circumstances are extraordinary.
- 4. Bursaries and scholarships will be announced at various times, and funds will be awarded when students provide proof of attendance at a recognized post-secondary institution. For our purposes, "post-secondary institution" shall be defined as follows:
 - a. A recognized university
 - b. Colleges offering transfer courses
 - c. Institutions which prepare students for specific trades and vocations and which are recognized and supported by the government (eg. BCIT)
- 5. Applications for financial help to attend other institutions will be considered and awards may be granted at the discretion of the committee. A valid student card or a receipt for tuition fees is required as proof of registration.
- 6. The candidate's academic achievement will be based on a review of an official transcript of the candidate's academic record for grades 11 and 12.
- 7. Scholarships are classed as earnings and reportable to CRA. Recipients of a scholarship will be required to provide their social insurance number, if they have not already done so, prior to receiving their award.
- 8. Please note winners names and photos may be published in local newspapers.
- 9. The funds provided through these scholarships must be used for tuition, fees and books. Other post-secondary expenses are not covered through these bursaries.

- See your Counselor or your Scholarship Coordinator for this document.
- If your semester two interim marks are not recorded on your Diploma Verification, see your teacher(s) and ask for a printout of your marks and include it with your application.

Two reference letters as follows:

- One letter must be from a principal, counsellor or teacher in your school
- One letter must be from an adult who supervised you during your volunteer work with an officially recognized community organization. This cannot be a school and/or school district sponsored activity.
 - * Both letters must:
 - show evidence of having worked with youth or children (ex. Peer tutoring or coaching), citizenship and/or leadership experiences.
 - be one page maximum
 - have a physical or digital signature (typed/scripted signatures are not accepted)
 - be on official letterhead of the organization or school (if letterhead is not available the letter must include all the letter writer's contact information and relationship to you)

Pay attention to the following:

Current year? If not, find the correct version.

Must be typed (forms are fillable, otherwise, automatic disqualification)

PROCESS TO APPLY:

- Each high school is only able to send ONE applicant for each scholarship so apply for as many you qualify for to increase your chances of having one (or more) of your applications submitted to the District Scholarship Selection Committee.
- Your application will need to speak for itself so be mindful of what you write. Be clear, be articulate and be concise.

Each slide will contain information on each of Partners36 Scholarships available:

- Name and amount of the scholarship;
- The criteria/eligibility information required for the scholarship;
- Any attachments required to be included with the application;
- The link to the application for the scholarship. Do NOT Google any of these scholarships as there are several versions (incorrect years) and using the incorrect application is an automatic disqualification.



SUGGESTIONS FOR APPLYING:

- 1. Even though the "deadline" is in April, there's A LOT to read and DO. **Start NOW!** Use Spring Break to work on your applications there's no reason to delay!
- 2. Remember that what you write will be what will do your talking for you. Make sure:
 - You ANSWER THE QUESTION;
 - The first few sentences grab the reader's attention or it may discourage them from continuing to read;
 - You write from your heart;
 - To **EDIT!! EDIT!!!** Check for spelling and grammar errors! Have other people read it and be open to their feedback (you've been looking at this for a while and it's easy to miss typos/errors).
 - YOU ANSWERED THE QUESTION?!?!
 - The number of words used to express your story, is it over the maximum limit allotted? If so, edit, edit, edit!!!
- 3. Do you have reference letters to submit? If not, <u>ask</u> the appropriate person(s) (stated in the instructions of the scholarship) **NOW** if they could write one for you. Do **NOT** ask for a reference letter days before you need it; <u>give your referee at least two to three weeks to compose it and send it to you as a PDF file.</u> Ensure you (and they) follow the instructions provided regarding:
 - What information the letter should contain; it must confirm and support your involvement regarding the "specified criteria"; tell them what the scholarship is about;
 - What the letter should include (signature and on letterhead);
 - Their letters should be addressed to "the Members of the Partners36 Scholarship Selection Committee".
 - **NOTE:** A Teacher who is a school coach CANNOT write a community letter unless that teacher coached you on a community team.

Don't hesitate to ask questions but read everything first!

Submit applications to Ms. Crocker electronically, "save" each scholarship application submission (with all of its components minus your Diploma Verification) as a PDF file with the following file name: Scholarship Name – Your Last Name, Your First Name – 045.

- Have an average of C or better;
- Outstanding achievement in one or more of the following technology education areas:

- A Diploma Verification form that includes your T2 marks;
- A reference form from a Technology Education teacher that must be signed and attached to your application.
 (Suggestion: Fill out the complete application and forward it to your Tech Ed teacher to fill out their portion and have them send it to Ms. Crocker.)

 - An adult who supervised you during your volunteer work with an officially recognized community organization. This cannot be a school and/or school district sponsored activity. (ie. employer, community organization/club leader, supervisor or community coach, etc.)
 - Letters must show evidence of having worked with youth or children (ie. peer tutoring or coaching), citizenship and leadership experiences. All letters must be one page maximum and have a physical or digital signature and be on the official letterhead of the organization. - Provide evidence of the following:
 - Demonstrate financial need;
 - Meet minimum academic requirements to be accepted into a post-secondary education or training program

Documents required in addition to the application form:

- A Diploma Verification that includes your T2 marks;
- Two reference letters:
 - One from a Principal, Counsellor or a teacher in your school;
 - Letters must show evidence of leadership, citizenship (social responsibility), or volunteer service and show commitment to the intended area of study. All letters must be one page maximum and have a physical or digital signature and be on the official letterhead of the organization. If this is not available, the letter must include all the letter writer's contact information and relationship to you.


