

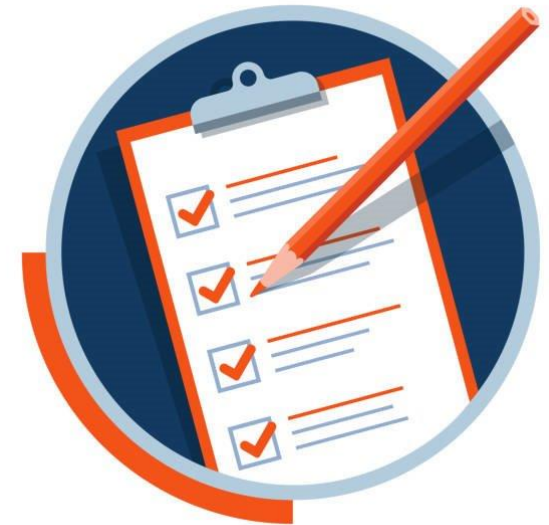

SUMMER SCHOOL, ONLINE SCHOOL & NIGHT SCHOOL

- Summer School:

- Registration begins in April (after Spring Break)
- **Not recommended** to take core academics for the first time in Summer school; recommended for upgrading core academics
- If choosing a course for summer school, do not select the same course in
course selections

- Online Courses (SAIL):

- Check with the PSI as to when the course must be completed by
- Highly recommended to complete all SAIL courses by **Jan. of Grade 12 year**

• Night School:

- Must be **16** years old as of July 1st

TIMETABLE PROCESS

- Course Request Portal closes Sunday, January 25th, 2026
- In **late February**, students in grade 8-11 will get a **chance to verify** their course selection requests from January.
- Request classes thoughtfully. **There is very limited capacity to accommodate course request changes following the spring request process.**

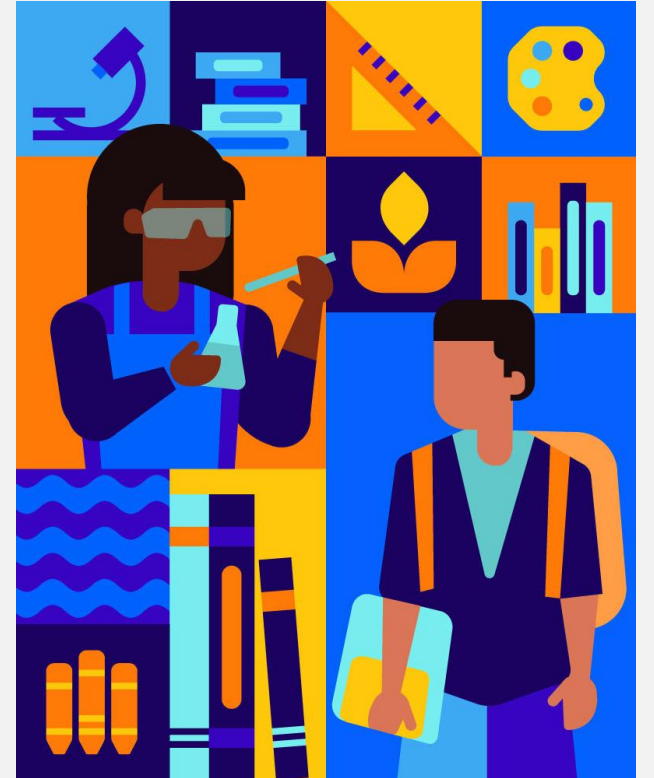

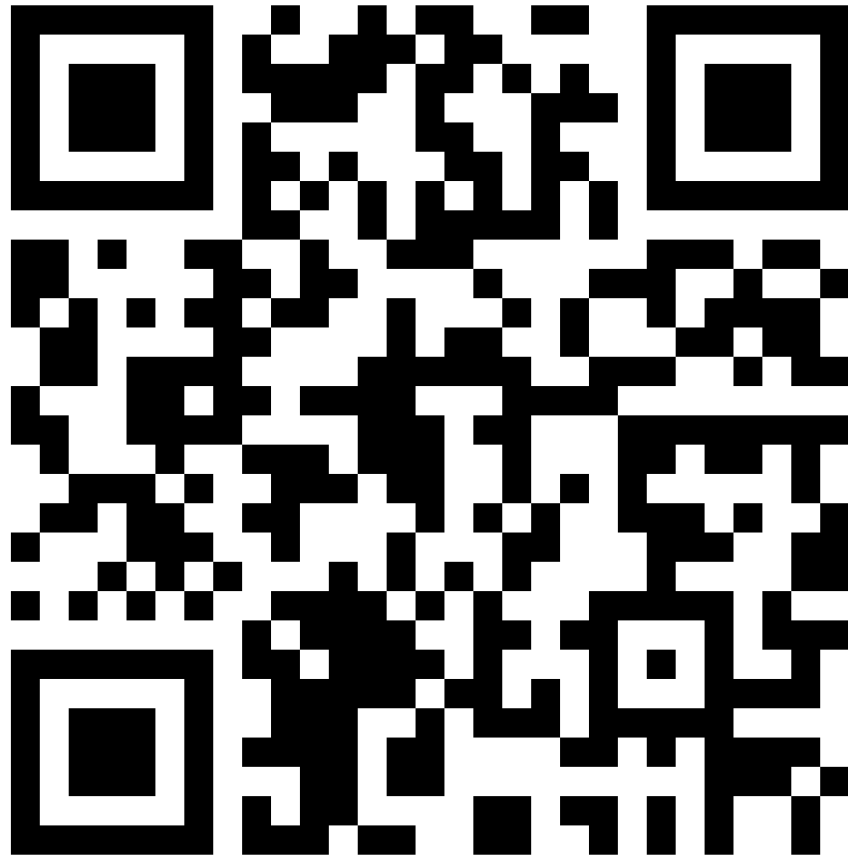

Five Courses in 1 semester:

- Accounting 11 **or** 12 (4 credits), Economic Theory 12 (4 credits SS), Marketing and Promotions 11 **or** Entrepreneurship 12 (4 credits), Career Life Connections and Capstone (CLC 12) (4 credits) **and** WEX 12A (4 credits)

Requirements:

- Must have excellent school attendance, and be at least 15 years of age and have parent consent
- Must apply during course selection (select Business Co-Op option/ not individual courses)

- Provides valuable experience for your resume

DEADLINES, EARLY ADMISSIONS AND GRADE 11 MARKS

- Some programs are "*first qualified, first admitted*" and others are "*competitive*"- check website and Education Planner BC
- **Grade 11 Marks:** will be looked at and counted for certain programs
- See Education Planner BC for info as deadlines for each program/school may vary

REPORTING MARKS/ STS

- **Student Transcript Service (STS):**

- Grade 12 students will be provided information on this process at an assembly

- No need to send in individual transcripts for PSI applications

APPLICATION TIPS FOR POST-SECONDARY

- Check **application deadlines** as each institution **varies**
- Start **researching** in grade **11**
- Start applying in grade **12**
- All application portals will be **open by beginning of October**
- **Recommended to finish applications by end of Winter Break** (grade 12s only)
- Consider **applying to more than one institution** (with varying entrance requirements)

- For all **Alberta** post-secondary institutions, apply through ***Apply Alberta***: <https://applyalberta.ca>
- For all **Ontario** post-secondary institutions, apply through ***Ontario Universities' Application Centre (OUAC)***: <https://www.ouac.on.ca>

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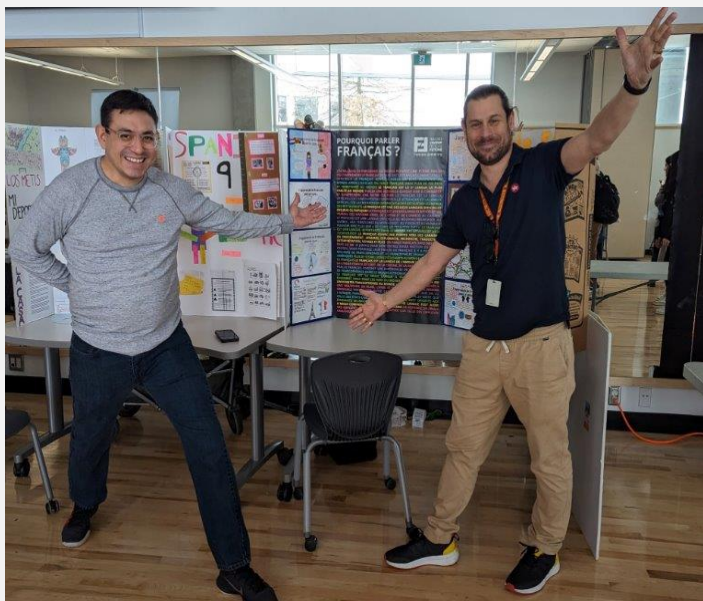
