Treasurer's Report

General Account

- Opening balance: \$8,420.85
- Reimbursements to various PAC members for the concession at the *Lion King Jr.* musical and teacher appreciation: \$489.41
- Square One credit from the musical: \$244.48
- Banking fees: \$4.50
- Closing balance: \$8,171.43

Gaming Account

- Opening balance: \$12,281.83
- Payment for field trip fees: \$608.00
- Closing balance: \$11,673.83

Maria reviewed a banking package that could reduce e-transfer costs. One package offers unlimited e-transfers if a minimum balance of \$1,500 is maintained; however, cheques would cost \$0.75 each.
