- Surplus to carry forward from last year
 - o \$10,000 income
- In-class experiences (children aren't charged for these experiences) teachers requested funding for those activities - budget is increased to \$20 per student, each classroom is also going to get \$250 for classroom items - in-class field trips can be provided with these
- Capital Projects \$20,000 PAC budgeted (additional charges could be pending from the outdoor learning center)
- New Capital project idea still pending Diane suggested sending out a survey to staff
- \$10,000 technology budget (could be used if not needed for the outdoor learning budget)
- Most other items are comparable to previous years
- Grade 7 leaving ceremony donation of \$1000 to be given, potentially another \$1000 towards the end of the year
- Sean surplus we had planned to do two fundraisers this year, we are going to leave the raffle this year and go ahead with the Spring Carnival as the main fundraiser
