
2026 - 2027 Boundary Map



Documents Required for Registration

The following documents **must be provided** with registration application as per the Surrey School District's Registration Policy.

Part 1: Required Documentation

- Photo identification for the parent or guardian (Driver's Licence, Passport, photo BC Services Card, BCID card, Indigenous documentation).
- Guardianship documentation naming the parent or guardian (Birth Certificate, a Legal Guardianship or Custody Order, immigration or court documents).
- Evidence of birth date for the student (Birth Certificate, Passport/NEXUS Pass, Canada Immigration Document, Permanent Resident Card, Court Order, or other governmentissued document).
- Canadian citizenship status for the parent or guardian (Canadian Birth Certificate, Citizenship Card or Certificate, Passport, Permanent Resident Card or Confirmation of Permanent Residency).
 - Families with temporary immigration status must provide an Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC) document such as one of the following: Work Permit, Study Permit, or Refugee Claimant Document.

Part 2: Evidence of Residence for the Parent/Guardian in British Columbia

- BC government-issued photo identification with address.
 - Documents accepted:
 - ✓ BC Driver's Licence
 - ✓ BC Services Card
 - BCID or ICBC Registration Document
- When there is no government-issued photo identification, the principal determines address of residence based on two documents that show the name of the parent/guardian:
 - ✓ Property Purchase agreement
 - / Utility Bill
 - ✓ Rental Agreement (or letter from Landlord)
 - Health Documents (medical reports and letters)
 - ✓ Letter-Mail with Name and address of Resident
 - Employment Pay-Slips
 - ✓ Bank Statements
 - ✓ Letter from Employer
 - √ Insurance statements or policies
 - ✓ Statement or Letter from a Notary Public
 - Other documents that indicate resident's name and address

Most Recent Report Card or Transcript of Grades (required)

Part 4: Other Documentation

Health documents (care card, immunization records, medical condition information)

Once these documents have all been received, your registration will be complete.
