#### HOLLY SCHOOL FEES 2017/2018

Each school year, parents support their child(ren)'s formal learning experiences in a wide variety of ways. We appreciate all that you do to ensure a successful year! The school district requires that we inform parents of upcoming school fees.

#### Student Planner:

As part of the provincial student learning grant, the student planner has been reduced from \$5 to \$2 for the 2017-18 school year. The remaining funds from this learning grant have been used to provide learning resources to schools. At Holly, we have a generous and hard working parent group (Holly Society) and they will be paying for the balance of the student planners making them FREE!

#### Field Studies and Field Trips:

The Holly Society also supports students by providing financial support for various events and field studies throughout the school year. District grants also cover many costs of field studies; however, we do sometimes ask parents to contribute to special events. Throughout the school year parents may be requested to pay anywhere from \$2.00 to \$25.00 for various field trips.

#### Musical Instruments:

Grade 7 band students are given options to purchase, rent or borrow instruments. Holly has a good selection of instruments if rental or purchase costs are too high.

At all times these fees are optional. We, at Holly, are committed to all students taking part in activities and, if at any time, you are asked to fund an event or supplies for your child and the cost is too much, please call us at the office and we will do our best to confidentially help you.
