Please sign all forms and <u>return them to your child's</u> <u>teacher as soon as possible</u>.

Student Information/Verification Forms will also be coming home soon! *Please confirm the address, phone numbers, contact persons & medical information is correct.* This information can also be updated at the office at any time throughout the year.

NOTE: We must have a working contact number at all times.

ELECTRONICS

We recommend that <u>all</u> electronic items be left at home unless a teacher is requesting them for learning purposes.



<u>Please Note</u>: If you choose to have your child bring a personal device from home (ie, phone, ipad, ipod, games, mp3s, etc.), the school will <u>not</u> be responsible for theft or any damage.

If electronic items are brought to school they <u>MUST</u> remain in the student's backpack and turned off during school hours, including recess and lunch. Their use will not be permitted at any time throughout the day unless the teacher requests they be used for school work.

Every classroom has a telephone that may be used by the student, with a teacher's permission, to call for emergencies or important matters only.

SCHOOL MEAL PROGRAM **** PLEASE READ THIS CAREFULLY ****



Once again Holly will be having the school meal program.

A few points to consider:

- Forms must be signed every month by the parent and returned to the teacher BEFORE THE FIRST DAY OF EVERY MONTH!
- Please note any food allergies and/or food restrictions (<u>for religious reasons only</u>) on the form.
- It is very important that your children eat what is provided on the lunch program. There is a daily menu included on the back of each form; should your child not like what is on the menu then he or she must bring a lunch from home on that day.
- FOOD IS NOT TO BE THROWN IN THE GARBAGE IF YOUR CHILD DOES NOT LIKE IT!
- FOOD IS NOT TO BE TAKEN HOME
- We need your support to ensure that our meal program is continued.

SCHOOL VISITORS

In the interest of safety, <u>everyone entering the</u> <u>school or the grounds must check in at the office</u>.

Classrooms are busy learning places and we try not to interrupt them during instructional time. If you need to see your child, leave him or her a message, or drop off a lunch, our office staff will happily take care of that for you. As well, it is difficult at the end or beginning of the school day for our office staff to have in-depth discussions with parents. Making appointments either by phone or in person is preferable.

ACCIDENT INSURANCE (FORMS ARE AT THE OFFICE)

The Surrey School District does not insure for expenses incurred if a student is injured on school grounds or during school activities, and the Medical Services Plan (MSP) is limited and does not cover all of the charges. However, families have the opportunity to purchase private accident insurance through the IAP Kids Plus™ Accident Insurance program, underwritten by Industrial-Alliance Pacific Life Insurance.

The plan's features include:

- Coverage 365 days a year, 24 hours a day, in or out of school
- Coverage of expenses that are limited, or not insured under private or group insurance plans or MSP, including private tutors, lump sum payment for fractures and dislocations, counselling, rehabilitation and more
- Coverage of injury-related dental work, including future expenses
- Fully-transferable insurance from school-toschool anywhere in Canada
- Optional premium plans cover babysitting costs or a teen's wages from a part time job, should a student be homebound due to injuries
