Entertainment

1. Quotes for entertainment provided by The Metro:
 - Hypnotist
 - Fortune Teller
 - Caricature Artist - \$700 for two artists for 4hrs (\$350 per artist)
 - Magician - \$1,600 for one person for 3hrs (\$500 per hour plus the booking fee)
 - Photo Booth – it's a package add on
 - Tattoo Artist - \$650 for 3hrs
 - Magician (Rick Mearns – travelling magician can be seen at Big Ridge and Rusty's etc.) \$950 for 3hrs
2. If we want to book our own entertainment, we must pay the fee up front to hold and confirm the reservation for the entertainer
3. If we book entertainment through The Metro, they handle all the reservations, with a \$100 per entertainer booking fee upfront for us

Food

1. The Metro Hall can put on a Dessert Sundae Bar
 - a. Costs are \$12.95 per person
 - i. \$2,590 for 200
 - ii. \$1,295 for 100
2. The Metro Hall can do a food buffet
 - a. Costs are \$17.95 per person (includes sliders, tacos, japadogs)
 - i. \$3,590 for 200
 - ii. \$1,795 for 100
3. Taco Del Mar

- a. Costs are \$11.95 per person PLUS \$5.00 per person fee from The Metro Hall (total \$16.95)
