# **Grad Dinner and Dance**

## **Dinner Dance Guest Passes:**

All guests of graduates must be approved by administration. Guest pass applications are available at the office and can be submitted to the office between April 4<sup>th</sup> and April 16<sup>th</sup>. The number of approved guests will be limited due to availability of space.

## **Dinner Dance Ticket Sales:**

Dinner Dance tickets will be on sale from Friday, April 26<sup>th</sup> until Thursday, May 2<sup>nd</sup> at lunch. Ticket prices are \$110.00 for students and \$120.00 for guests. Tickets will be distributed to students in their TAG class on June 21<sup>st</sup>.

## **Dinner Dance Ticket Sales Instructions: (to be completed before buying tickets)**

- Choose ONE person from your table to be the Group Buyer. The Group Buyer will collect the names and money for the entire group (including guests) and will purchase the tickets at lunch on the dates listed above.
- Make a table group. There can be up to ten people per table. If your table is less than ten people, you may have to combine with another table. In order to secure your table and the people you are sitting with, it is strongly recommended that you choose as close to ten people as possible. Note that only your table will be reserved for you – where you actually sit at the table will be first-come, first-served.
- Fill out the Group Buyer Form with information from each student at the table (form available online or at the office one week before ticket sales start). Collect the money from each student or guest (cheques must have student ID on the back). Students may also pay online at <https://surreyschools.schoolcashionline.com>. Students who have fundraised money in order to reduce their ticket price can deduct that amount from their ticket cost and record the deduction on the Group Buyer Form. The available amount of fundraising to be deducted will be posted at the office.
- Select your table number preference from the Table Set-up Chart posted at the office.
- Only the Group Buyer brings the filled out form and online receipts, money or cheques to the conference room (by the office) during lunch from April 26<sup>th</sup> – May 2<sup>nd</sup>.

## **Dinner Dance and Dry Grad Transportation:**

On June 26<sup>th</sup> all students attending the dinner dance will be boarding a chartered bus and transported to the Tsawwassen Springs. All students must be present at the school to board the assigned bus. Students will not be permitted access to the dinner dance if they arrive via their own transportation. The schedule for June 26<sup>th</sup> is as follows:

**4:15 pm – all students are at the school, checking in bags, ready to load onto buses**

**5:00 pm – students loading onto buses**

**5:15 pm – all buses leave Enver Creek**

**6:00 pm – arrive at Tsawwassen Springs**

**11:15 pm – all students will be loaded onto buses for transportation to Enver Creek**

**Commencement Tickets:**

Commencement tickets will be available for purchase starting on Tuesday, May 7<sup>th</sup> at lunch and ending on Friday, May 10<sup>th</sup> at lunch. Each graduate will be entitled to a maximum of 4 tickets at a cost of \$2.00 per ticket and may request to be put on a wait list for additional tickets.

On Thursday, May 16<sup>th</sup>, starting at lunch, two of the previously requested additional tickets on the wait list may be released for purchase at a cost of \$5.00 each on a first-come, first served basis. After this release, any remaining tickets still available on the wait list will be released in the same manner (two at a time) until sold out. *Graduates themselves do not need a commencement ticket.* Tickets will be handed out to students at the Commencement rehearsal on May 28<sup>th</sup>.

**Commencement Rehearsal Assembly:**

All grads must attend the Commencement Rehearsal Assembly scheduled for 1:30 pm on Tuesday, May 28<sup>th</sup> in the Enver Creek gymnasium. Following the assembly, students will receive their cap, tassel and gown. Students must return their gown immediately after the commencement recessional. No gowns will be permitted to leave Chandos Pattison Auditorium after commencement, and students will be charged for gowns that have not been returned. Grads may keep their cap and tassel as a souvenir. A photographer will take a photo of each graduate as he/she crosses the stage and the photo will be given to each student before the end of June.

**Commencement – Thursday, May 30, 2019:**

Grads should arrive at Chandos Pattison Auditorium (10238 – 168 Street, Surrey) at 5:45 pm sharp. Seating for parents and guests will start shortly after 6:00 pm and guests must be seated by 6:45 pm in order to see the processional. Please note that guests not seated by 6:45 pm will need to wait outside until the processional is completed.
