With the purpose of promoting empathy and inclusion in our school community, the theme of this year's contest is 'putting yourself in someone else's shoes'. Write a piece based on this statement and follow the rules of entry below.

## **Categories:**

Students may enter no more than <u>TWO (2)</u> pieces of writing in <u>each</u> category – a maximum of **FOUR (4)** in total:

<u>Category 1:</u>Prose – includes short story & essay

<u>Category 2:</u>Verse – includes poetry/slam and spoken word/rap (Written)

## **Entry Rules:**

- Entries **must** be typed in 12pt Times New Roman font.
- First & last name, grade level, and email written on the back of each piece
- o Each Prose and/or Verse entry must not exceed word limit:

Grade 8 & 9: 500 words maximum per entry

Grade 10-11: 1000 words maximum per entry

\*Please ensure all language and content are school appropriate or your entry will be disqualified. Additionally, entries must be original work; plagiarized works will be disqualified.

Students can submit their entries to any English teacher before April 2, 2019, no later than 2:30PM. Late submissions will not be accepted.

Winners with best piece/pieces based on the theme will be awarded prizes. They will also be given opportunities to present their work throughout the school.
