This has been the most unusual month of April in the history of Earl Marriott and I am so in awe of the resilience and flexibility shown by our entire community. We are now well into **Week Five of our on-line learning**, and everyone has risen to the challenge. I am so grateful to all of our teachers and staff for the additional hours they have put in to create activities and lessons that work in a virtual environment for their students, and for the effort and learning it has taken to reach out and engage all their students in TEAMS and online platforms. Thank you to the parents who have shown us only kindness as we moved forward, and who have given encouragement and supported our students in their homes to make this all work. Most of all, thank you to our students, who are engaging and continuing to do their best work, despite having lost the richness of everything that a real school community brings. We know that this is not what you were expecting when you began your year, and we are so proud of how you are stepping up and doing what needs to be done to move everyone forward and keep everyone safe.

You will be receiving the third formal report card, the first for Semester 2, which will be posted for students and parents in MyEdBC on **Thursday, April 30th**. This year, all students will be working in their online classes until **Friday, June 19th**, with an opportunity for **completion activities with their teachers June 23rd^h –26**th. Completion days are opportunities for students to complete missed exams, and finish off assignments. There are no scheduled Provincial assessments this year, other than Grade 12 students who have not completed their Numeracy assessment. Students should now be communicating with their teachers about how they can engage in their classes until the end of semester, and meet their personal goals for the year in the best way possible. Please use all of the supports available through the school and on-line to stay focused and organized. If there are any questions or concerns about your son or daughter's progress, please contact your teacher directly through email.

There were many events on our school calendar that have now passed us by, and many more to come where we will not be able to gather as we typically would. Our staff is busy planning for a virtual event for our Graduates, to honour them and celebrate this moment in their lives. We hope that it will be a day to remember, if not exactly like they had imagined. It is important to remember that, despite all of the loss, things are moving forward as they should for many of our students and our Grade 12's in particular. We have received news that several of our students have been offered tremendous scholarships, and this month many have received letters of acceptance to University and post-secondary programs. 
