#### **Steps to Volunteer:**

- 1. Choose volunteer experience that you will enjoy. Think about what interests you in life and come up with types of work you might want to do now or in the future.
- 2. **Do some research.** You will need research skills throughout your life for work or personal interests. When you have chosen some fields of interest search the internet to find volunteer websites or opportunities that exist in your area.
- 3. **Follow the instructions carefully.** It is important to submit the application and supporting documents in the manner the company or organization requests. (ie. electronically, in person, or by mail.)
- 4. **Attend an information session or orientation meeting.** Many organizations will require you to attend an orientation prior to starting your volunteer experience.
- 5. **Make a good first impression.** Make sure to show up on time and follow all the instructions. Don't be afraid to ask questions.
- 6. **Help to raise awareness of the issue** by talking about what you are doing. This will help to boost community support.
- 7. Make sure that you receive recognition and/or evidence of the hours that you worked: ie. a reference letter, a certificate or an in-school service hour log sheet with your volunteer coordinator/manager's signature including the dates, hours and activities that you did. You need 30 hrs of volunteer or employment to meet the Grad Transition requirements. (Can be achieved in Gr. 10-12)
- 8. **Celebrate what you have accomplished** and remember, what you have done is important and you have made a difference in your community!
- 9. **Think about future volunteer experience.** Maybe you can try something new or expand your current experience or knowledge.
