## Mountainview Montessori 2023-2024 School Fees - Grades 4-7

Each school year, parents support their child(ren)'s formal learning experiences in a wide variety of ways. We appreciate all that you do to ensure a successful year!

**Student Supplies:** Parents/Guardians are to purchase, from their vendor of choice student supplies. A basic itemized school supply list will come home in June and will be posted on our school website. Total cost of school supplies should not exceed \$65.

In addition to providing the school supplies itemized on a grade list, parents are periodically asked for monies to cover specific items and/or special events. No student will be denied the opportunity to participate in any school activity due to the inability to pay. Please contact the principal should you require any financial assistance.

As we plan for the upcoming school year, we anticipate the following costs:

**Student Planner:** We encourage all students in Grades 4-7 to purchase a School Planner at a cost of \$5.00. Included in the planner is our school code of conduct, school calendar and school district information. We find this to be an excellent tool for facilitating home/school communication, as well as for developing our students' organizational skills.

**Field Studies and Field Trips:** Classes often enjoy educational visits to community facilities which extend and enhance the curriculum. While we use school monies or fundraise to cover the costs of such activities wherever possible, there are times when parents are asked to contribute towards the cost of the trip. If you choose to have your child not participate in a field study, a suitable program will be provided at the school.

**Camp:** In the intermediate years, students participate in a 3-day, 2-night camp experience. Students fundraise towards their camp costs which range from \$250-\$300 each year. No student will be denied the opportunity to participate in camp due to the inability to pay. Please contact the principal should you require any financial assistance.

**Musical Instruments:** Grade 7 students can either purchase or rent an instrument for band. Costs vary depending on the instrument. Parent/Guardians purchase/rent from their choice of vendor.

Fees will be collected in September through SchoolCashOnline once students are in classes.
