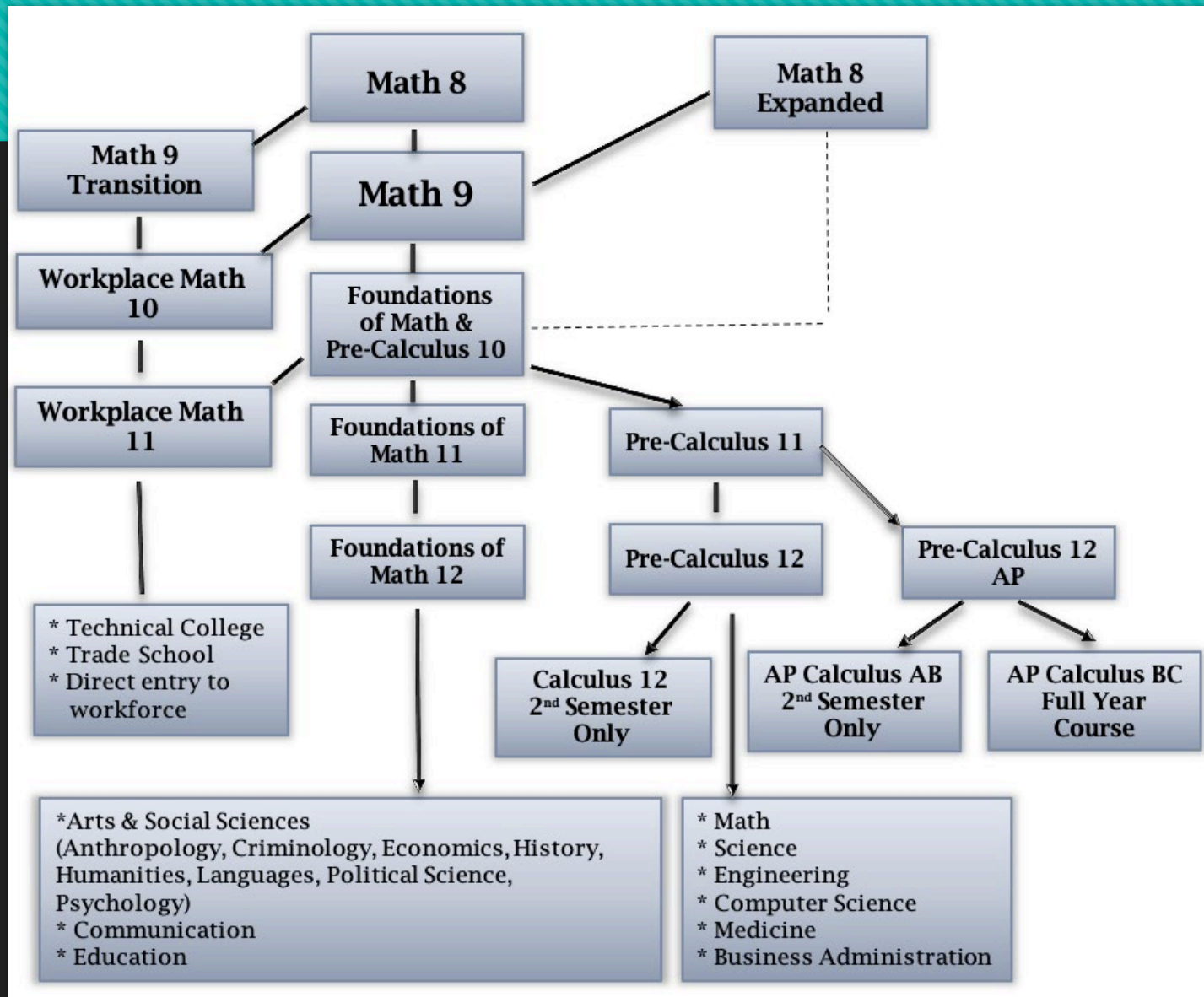
All focused on the key English skills:

Alternates

- Choose one alternate for English
- Choose two alternates for your Electives

Don't choose a course twice!

X Block

- Optional
- Offered outside of regular class time
- At lunch or after school

Study Blocks

- **No Off-site Learning Blocks**
- **Grade 10's do not have study block option**
- **Grade 11's will have the opportunity to request a study block**
- **Grade 12's will have the opportunity to request 1-2 study blocks**

- If you do not get into Summer School, contact counsellor immediately
- No guarantee the course can be added back
- Need to register with Continuing Education for Summer School

Grade Ten Course Selection

Each Grade 10 student is required to take the following courses, which will automatically be selected for each student:

- Social Studies 10
- Science 10
- Career Life Education 10

Students must choose:

- One English 10 course
- One Math 10 course
- One PE 10 course
- Three Elective courses (Arts Education Elective, Applied Design, Skills & Technologies (ADST) Elective and/or Language Elective)
- Two Alternate electives
- One Alternate English 10





Do not choose a course more than once. Duplicate requests will be deleted.

Instructions Regarding Full Credit Summer School/Online School



- If the course is a **REQUIRED** course for graduation, you will have no choice but to select it. Put a note in the **Counsellor Notes** in the portal to let the counsellor know what course you are intending to take in summer school/online **and what you want instead** of that required course.
- If the course you plan to take in summer school/online is an elective (i.e. Spanish 11), select a different course (i.e. Woodwork 11 - not the one you are taking in summer school/online). You do not need to let your counsellor know in this case.
- If you do not get accepted into the summer school course, contact your counsellor immediately to try to get the course back into your Fraser Heights timetable. Be aware that this may not be possible and you will have to choose another course instead.
- Note: It is your responsibility to register for Summer School through Continuing Education
