
The school is indeed a busy place, but we always have time for you. If you need to connect about anything, please do call the school or come by.





#### The Many Deaths of...





### **Lessons in Chemistry**




Chemist Elizabeth Zott is not your average woman. But it's the early 1960s and her all-male team at Hastings Research Institute takes a very unscientific view of equality.
