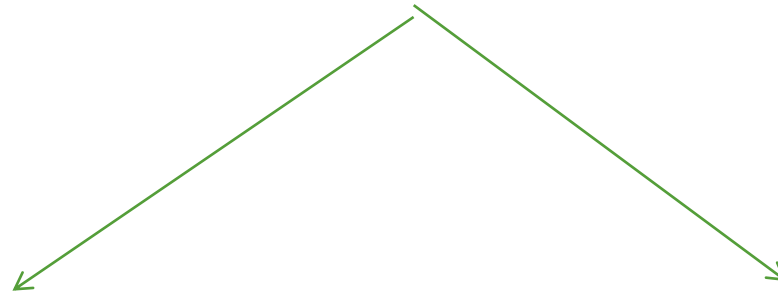
Timeline

Going into Grade 10, English-Language Program? Then you are in the right place!

Students entering the Grade 10 English-Language program next year will be making requests based on the following requirements:

- English 10; Choose one of the English courses in the selection box
- Math 10; Choose one of the Math courses in the selection box
- Science 10 (pre-selected)
- Social Studies 10 (pre-selected)
- Career Life Education 10 (2 credit non-enrolling course - 9th course) (pre-selected)
- Physical and Health Education 10 or
 - PHE 10 with Band 10 year-long (2 Courses)
 - PHE 10 with Rec Leadership 10 year-long (2 courses)
 - Hockey Academy 10 - PHE 10 and one elective (2 courses)
- Three additional elective courses or two if you selected PHE 10/Band or Rec Lead, or Hockey Academy
- In addition, students may choose the following as a tenth course: Jazz Band 10 (before school)
- Two Alternate Courses (You cannot repeat courses you have already requested above)

Notes:

- One of the Ministry of Education graduation requirements is that students are required to take at least one Fine Arts or Applied Skills before they complete Grade 12. Please refer to the Course Planning Sheet for the starred options.
- Students are required to have a complete timetable of 9 courses including the 2 credit non-enrolling CLC 10 course. Students should meet with the counselling department if academic accommodations are required. Students should review their course selections with their parents and see their counsellor if they have any questions.
