
Choose ONE of the two following options:

- Literary Studies/Composition
 Literary Studies is the study of various themes, authors, and genres.
 Students will deepen their understanding of themselves, others, and the world through the study of a variety of texts and various forms of media.
 Composition develops a student's written communication through the exploration of literature in a variety of contexts. Students will explore and create coherent, purposeful compositions while developing and refining their writing abilities.
- Creative Writing/Composition
 Creative Writing is the opportunity for students to play with words and develop lifelong languages skills through the writing process. This course provides students with in-depth opportunities to become better writers through the exploration of personal and cultural identities, memories, and stories in a wide range of genres. Composition develops a student's written communication through the exploration of literature in a variety of contexts. Students will explore and create coherent, purposeful compositions while developing and refining their writing abilities.

Mathematics



Skill Building/Workplace Courses – For students who struggle with mathematics and do not intend to study at the college or university level (Applicable to some college programs). Additional remediation support may be available in the summer between grades 8 & 9.

Foundations Courses – For students who will likely attend a post-secondary program or college/university without a focus on math or science.

Pre-Calculus Course – For students who have <u>strong</u> mathematical abilities who intend to study math or science at a post-secondary school.

Options in Math







Math 10 Honours – Priority will be based on Math 9 marks and work habits.

Math 10 Workplace – For students intending to enter directly into the workforce or into most trade programs. For students who struggle with mathematics and do not intend to study at the college or university level.

Math 10 Foundations and Pre-Calculus– a course for students who successfully completed Math 9 and intend to study at the college or university level.







- English 10; Choose one of the English courses in the selection box
- . Math 10; Choose one of the Math courses in the selection box
- Science 10 (pre-selected)
- Social Studies 10 (pre-selected)
- · Career Life Education 10 or
 - CLE 10 with Band 10 year-long (2 Courses)
- Physical and Health Education 10 or
 - PHE 10 with Rec Leadership 10 year-long (2 courses)
 - Hockey Academy 10 PHE 10 and one elective (2 courses)
- Two additional elective courses or one if you selected CLE 10/Band, PHE 10/ Rec Lead, or PHE 10/Hockey Academy

Notes

- . One of the Ministry of Education graduation requirements is that students are required to take at least one Fine Arts or Appled Skills before they complete Grade 12. Please refer to the Course Planning Sheet for the starred options.
- Students are required to have a complete timetable of 9 courses including the 2 credit non-enrolling CLC 10 course. Students should meet with the counselling department if academic accommodations are required. Students should review their course selections with their parents and see their counsellor if they have any questions.




