# English Language Arts 11

8 senior credits are needed to graduate

- In Grade 11 choose ONE of...
  - ❖ **Literary Studies 11:** specific themes, authors, or areas of the world through literary works and media
  - ❖ **Composition 11:** focus on narrative, expository, descriptive, persuasive pieces
  - ❖ **Creative Writing 11:** exploration of personal and cultural identities, memories and stories
  - ❖ **English First Peoples 11:** more focus on authentic First Peoples texts, principles of learning, and oral traditions
  - ❖ **New Media 11:** a course designed to reflect the changing role of technology in society historically, currently, and in the future.

You require a Social Studies 11 or 12 credit to graduate in either Gr.11/12 year. Choices include:

- 20th Century World History 12
- BC First Nations 12

- Law Studies 12
- Philosophy 12
- Physical Geography 12

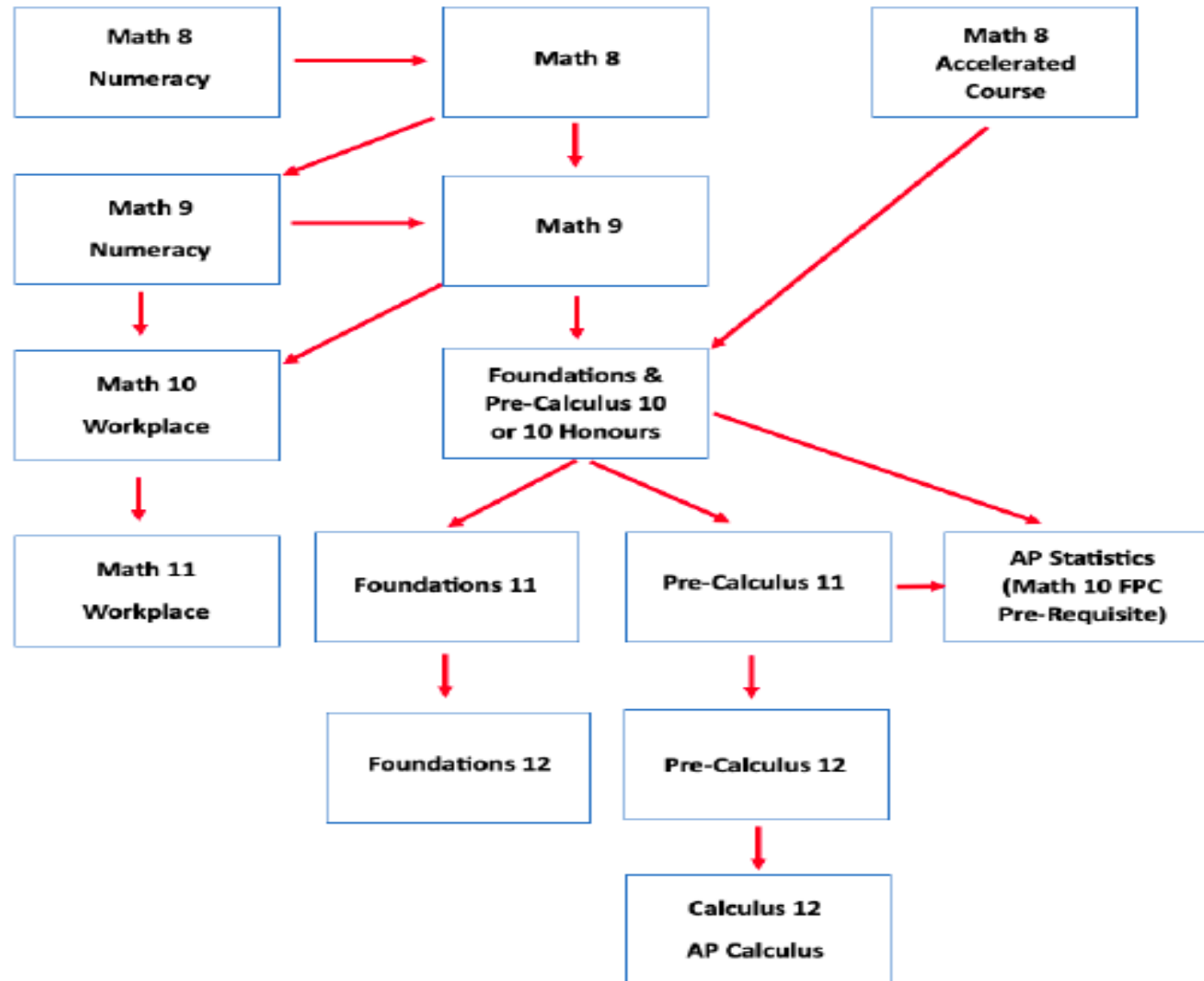


- **Math 11 Workplace** – a course for students who struggled through Math 10 Foundations and Pre-Calculus. Also open to all Math 10 Workplace students.
- **Math 11 Foundations** – a course for students who successfully completed Math 10 Foundations and Pre-Calculus.
- **Math 11 Pre-Calculus** - a course that is designed for students who plan on studying math or science or engineering in post-secondary [a challenging and demanding course]. Students should have at least a 73% in Math 10 Foundations and Pre-Calculus
- **Statistics 11/12 AP** - a course for strong math students in grades 11 and 12 who are planning to pursue studies in math, science, social sciences (i.e. psychology), or business. Students should have at least a 73% in Math 10 Foundations and Pre-Calculus. This is an Advanced Placement course (not on your sheet but available on the MYED portal)

# Electives

- 1 course (4 credits) in either Fine Arts or Applied Skills in Gr. 10, 11 or 12 is required by the end of Gr. 12
- Examples:

## A Second Language is Recommended

- A Language 11
  - will keep all doors open after high school
  - is a requirement for direct entry to some universities
  - A Language 12 may be required to complete a B.A.
  - Great for travel + cultural understanding
