

Kwantlen Park Secondary General Fees 2026-2027

Parents and students are advised of the following general fees and workbook pricing for the 2026-2027 school year. The school will provide the essential materials and resources necessary for students to meet the learning outcomes for each course. Students will need to continue to provide their own basic supplies and equipment for their own personal use such as paper, writing tools, calculators, notebooks, gym attire and musical instruments.

Some courses such as textiles and woodwork provide students with the option of using different or better-quality materials which they may bring from home or purchase from school at cost. Some courses offer optional certifications or external examinations for which there are charges.
