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Principal's Message

Welcome Back Wildcats!

Welcome to the 2026-2027 school year. We are all excited to welcome and welcome back our students and families. Teachers and support staff have been working hard preparing for the return of over 1300 Tamanawis students – it is an exciting time for everyone. As most of you know, we have returned to a regular day schedule with 4 blocks each day. Included in this newsletter is very important information regarding start-up, opening week and grade specific instructions. Orientation Day is September 8th; this day is an opportunity for students to refamiliarize themselves with the building, find their classes, and better understand the new schedule. Grades 8s will attend for 1.5 hours while grades 9-12 will be in school for 1 hour. Please see the full schedule below for specific details. We look forward to greeting you all starting September 8th in preparation for a full day of classes on Wednesday, September 9th.

One of the major school goals is to increase the academic performance of our students. We have created a plan that will encourage students to regularly attend their classes; arrive on time and be ready to learn; with a focus on school connection and success. We will continue to limit cell phone use to non-instructional time (lunch & breaks between classes). Teachers and administration will strictly enforce the cell phone policy. As educators, we know one of the greatest contributors to student success is attendance. When students arrive on time and attend all their classes, we see a significant increase in their marks and learning. It is our expectation that students attend all their classes every day; **we ask that parents support us in this initiative by having a conversation with their child prior to the start of school regarding these important commitments.**

We anticipate a smooth start to the 2026-2027 school year and look forward to seeing you all on September 8th.

Student Schedules and Absence Reporting

Grade 8 students: Students will receive their schedules during their homeroom on Tuesday September 8, 2026. Lists will be posted in the large gym alphabetically to assist students in finding their homeroom/Block B classes. All grade 8 students are asked to report to the large gym at 10:00am on September 8th.

Grades 9 to 12 students: Students will be able to access their course schedule for the upcoming year on the MyEducation BC student portal starting **Thursday, August 27, 2026**. **Prior to the start of school on Tuesday September 8, 2026, please check back into your account to confirm your schedule. From time-to-time schedules are changed for various reasons. It is highly recommended that you save your schedule to an electronic device after doing a final check on Monday September 7th.** If after viewing the schedule you need to contact a counsellor, please see the message from our counselling department on the next page.

Absence Reporting: In the Surrey School District (Surrey Schools), only [parents or legal guardians](#) are permitted to excuse students from school. If your child is going to be absent, late, or needs to leave early, please communicate by **emailing the school:** tamanawis@surreyschools.ca. Please include your child's full name and Student ID # and date absent or date and blocks to be excused.

Lockers

For the safety of students and staff, only approved school locks are to be used on all school lockers. DO NOT replace the locks. Students at Tamanawis Secondary will have access to a locker for this school year. Access to lockers is included in the 2026-2027 school fees. Grade 8: Homeroom teachers will assist the grade 8 students to access their lockers during the first week of school

Instructions for Reserving Lockers Online

1. Go to the locker administration web site for the school: <https://tam.lockerassignment.com>
 - Your login ID is your student number (refer to your go-card or your MyEd portal)
 - your password is a combination of your initials and your student number combined. Your two initials will be uppercase. (ie. Adam Smith with student number 123456 would have a password of: AS123456)
 - A map of the locker zones is included on the website
2. Select an area (zone) of the school where you would like your locker to be.
3. Click on a zone and the available lockers will appear.
 - Green means a locker is empty.
4. Select a locker. Once you have selected a locker you will be able to see the locker combination. You will also be able to login at any time in the future to see your assigned locker and combination.
5. Once you have selected a locker, you cannot change it through the online application. This will be your locker and lock for this school year.

Lunchtime and the School Cafeteria

Our school includes a teaching kitchen with food service for students.

The school cafeteria, Wildcat Café, normally provides hot & cold meals during lunchtime. All food and prepared meals will be individually packaged for sale.

Parking- Student Drop Off and Pick Up

To lessen traffic congestion in the morning and after school, we ask students to please walk or ride to school with a friend. Another alternative is for parents to pick up and drop off their student a short distance away from the school or at Tamanawis park. If you are dropping your child off at school, kindly be considerate of our neighbors and not block their driveways while picking up or dropping off your students for school. Please do not stop on 66th Avenue to pick up and drop off your child. Surrey Police traffic officers have notified us that this is a concern of theirs with respect to student safety. In addition, we ask all students who are crossing 66th Avenue on foot to use the clearly marked crosswalks. If you are waiting for your child in our parking lot, please do not block the entrance or exit while you wait. Our parking lot often becomes a safety concern because of the number of parent vehicles parked in our lot and on 66th Avenue. We ask all drivers in our parking lot to be especially mindful of the number of students walking and cars moving during our busy drop off and pick up times.

Scents & Sensitivity

We are a scent aware school. Scented products can adversely affect someone's health, which can contribute to allergic reactions, respiratory irritations, headaches, nausea, etc.

We share the air! Thank You for helping us contribute to a "scent aware" community by refraining from using any scented products.
