

POLICY #8100 SCHOOL COMPLETION CERTIFICATE

The Surrey Board of Education will award School Completion Certificates (SCC) based upon Ministerial Orders and Regulations under the *School Act*. School Completion Certificates are intended to recognize the accomplishments of students who have succeeded in meeting the goals of their educational program other than graduation.

GUIDING PRINCIPLES

The board is committed to ensure that processes are in place for all students, including students with special needs, which:

- a) Accurately identify students who require modifications to their educational program.
- b) Apply appropriate interventions to meet the educational needs of every student.
- c) Communicate accurately and regularly with parents and/or guardians regarding the educational program and progress of every student.

The board is committed to provide educational programs and services to students, including students with special needs, which:

- a) Are characterized by inclusionary practices that promote participation and interaction for all students.
- b) Allows those students to experience success and challenges them to strive toward their maximum potential.
- c) Are organized to provide equitable access to all areas of the curriculum across School District No. 36 (Surrey).
