

POLICY #8475 CAREER EDUCATION PROGRAMS

1. PHILOSOPHY

- 1.1. The Surrey Board of Education considers the experience, instruction and guidance provided to students through Career Education Programs to be highly beneficial to students' satisfaction with career choices.
- 1.2. Recognizing the value of Career Education programs, the board encourages their development and related activities.

2. <u>INTENT</u>

- 2.1. It is the intent of the board that Career Education experiences outside the school:
 - a) Constitute part of teaching methodologies to reach curriculum objectives.
 - b) Be planned to minimize risk.
 - c) Will have the responsibilities of the student, parent/guardian, sponsor/employer and the school district defined and agreed to in writing.

3. AUTHORITY

Administration is authorized to receive community input, establish and operate Career Education programs.

3.2 Administration is:

- Authorized to establish standard contractual agreements between the Board, parents, students and sponsors regarding the operation of Career Education experience arrangements.
- b) Authorized and responsible to enter into such agreements where students are involved in career education experiences away from school.
