Admission Procedures Checklist

	Signed Surrey Community College application form and \$90.00 non-refundable enrolment fee. Applicants must be at least 18 years of age.
	Photo Identification: Birth Certificate, Canadian passport, Canadian citizenship card or Permanent Residence Card
	English 12 with a minimum grade of C+ (67%) or Communications 12 with a minimum grade of A (86%) or a post-secondary English course with a minimum grade of C- (50%) from a recognized post-secondary institution where English is the primary language of instruction. An English assessment may be required.
	Proof of secondary school completion If you have studied out of the country your education credentials may need to be evaluated. We accept WES or visit <u>www.bcit.ca/ices</u> If you have a degree, you may not need to have the documents evaluated. Contact the office to check.
	Submit 2 Character Reference forms from a professional (non-family, non-friend)
	<u><i>Handwritten</i></u> letter of introduction outlining interest and experience with children, youth or adults with disabilities. Computer generated documents will not be accepted. This letter must be handwritten.
	Police Information Check- go to the RCMP/local police office in the city where you live and ask for a Police Information Check with vulnerable sector screening Date Issued:
	Once you have applied, applicants will then be scheduled for their Facilitated Conversation Meeting – an online group conversation with other applicants facilitated by college instructors. Date Attended:
