Adult Graduation Program

A student must be 18 years or older to gain entry to the Adult Graduation Program. The age requirement is the minimum age a student may begin, not end, the Adult Graduation Program.

Students who transfer to the Adult program at age 18 still need to complete at least 80% of course work after their 18th birthday for the courses to be eligible as courses “completed as an adult”.

An Adult Graduation Program student may receive credit toward an Adult Graduation Diploma for no more than two qualifying courses completed while in the B.C. Graduation Program. This means that the student must receive credit for at least three of the qualifying courses needed to meet Adult Graduation Program requirements after enrolling in the Program.
