We continue to have parking challenges both in our lot and in neighbouring properties. We know that parking is limited however, it really is necessary to respect private property at all times. Both Greenside and the commercial property across the street should not have to monitor their lots. Additionally, we still have parents parking in our staff lot which continues to be problematic. Below you will see the most recent email received regarding parking.

Please consider arriving 10 minutes after the bell or, if you are coming between 2:20-2:40, continue to circulate through the drive through until your child is ready (rather than attempting to park your car in our lot or the adjacent properties).

Good Afternoon,

I know we have connected with your school on a few occasions regarding parents using our parking lot next door for pick up and drop off at your school. We are the commercial building across from your school. While I can appreciate that it is hard for the school to enforce, we are concerned for the safety of students as well. **Our parking lot is strictly for the tenants of our complex.**

We can not allow our parking lot to be used for parking or drop off or pick up.

We have had numerous complaints about near misses in our parking lot. We have large trucks coming and going. There are many tenant vehicles that need access to this parking lot for their own parking or deliveries. Often they are not able to find parking by their own businesses due to parents parking. Often students are running across the parking lot to their parent's cars, and we have had close calls reported with vehicles. Safety of the children is important and we want to ensure everyone's safety.

I ask that you please get word out to your parent community and educate them on where they can be parking for pick ups or drop offs that does not include our commercial buildings parking lots.
