Friday- 'Fancy Friday'... Dress up in fancy clothes at home

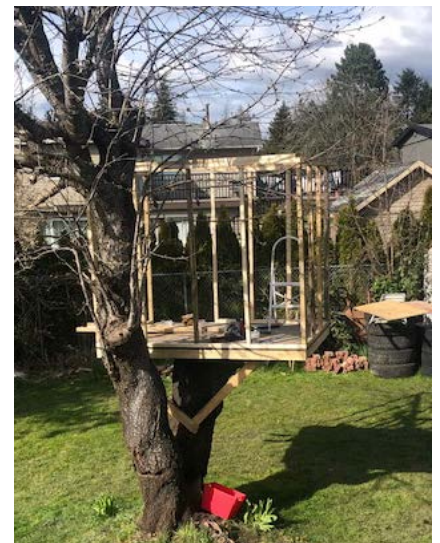
