
Student Led Conferences

IMPORTANT NOTICE SUPERVISION/ PICKUP AND DROP OFF



As the weather warms up we have children arriving at the school earlier and staying later. This is a friendly reminder to all parents and caregivers that WP does not provide supervision before 8:15 AM or after 2:50 PM. There <u>may</u> be staff in the building however, they are not responsible for supervising children outside the hours mentioned above. This is contractual – from both the STA and CUPE Unions.

The fee for service Daycare opens at 7:30 AM and closes at 5 PM should you need morning or after school supervision.

Your child's safety is of our utmost concern therefore we ask that you do not drop off your child before 8:15 AM or leave your child unattended after 2:50 PM. The staff cannot be expected to supervise beyond these hours.

** Please note, children are not to enter the school before the bell in the morning or remain in the building after 2:33 PM unless they are involved in a school sanctioned sport/activity.
