Welcome back! We hope that you all had a restful and safe Spring Break. As we move into the third term of the school year, health and safety of students and staff remains our number one concern. The Surrey School District along with Public Health have set increased protocols in schools to stop the spread of COVID-19. Starting March 29th, 2021 all students grades 4-12 will be required to wear a mask while inside the school. It is highly recommended to wash re-useable masks each evening before returning to school the next day.

The district has recommended that students and their families leave the school grounds, including the playground, basketball court and field, as soon as possible after the end of the school day. All parent and guardian inquiries are to be made over the phone or through email. Please call the office to arrange an appointment with staff or administration. **Only staff and students are permitted in the building until further notice.**

Please have your family complete the Health Check list prior to coming to school each day. It is vital that children, guardians, grandparents and parents stay home when they are not feeling well.

Friendly reminder that there are to be **no lunch drop off** during the school day this year. Please have your child(ren) bring their lunch and water bottle to school with them in the morning.

STUDENT LEARNING SURVEY 2020/2021

The Provincial Student Learning Survey is unique in its scope, size and usefulness to schools. It gathers information from parents/guardians/caregivers, teachers and students on topics related to school environment, safety, and achievement. The information is used for planning in individual schools and provides a district and provincial perspective. Early in 2021 the Student Learning Survey will be administered to students in grades 4 and 7 their parents/guardians/caregivers, and all school staff. We encourage parents/guardians/caregivers to participate in this survey, as the results are important in identifying and celebrating current strengths, as well as determining where the school needs to focus improvement. The surveys contain standard questions for the Province – in addition, questions from the school and/or district that focus on local conditions or issues may be included.

The survey can be completed electronically and can be accessed on the Internet at http://www.bced.gov.bc.ca/sat_survey

Any computer with an Internet connection can be used, and access to the e-survey is simple and secure. The survey can be accessed through the link with or without an anonymous logon code by selecting the school district and school name where your child attends school. STUDENT DAILY HEALTH CHECKS

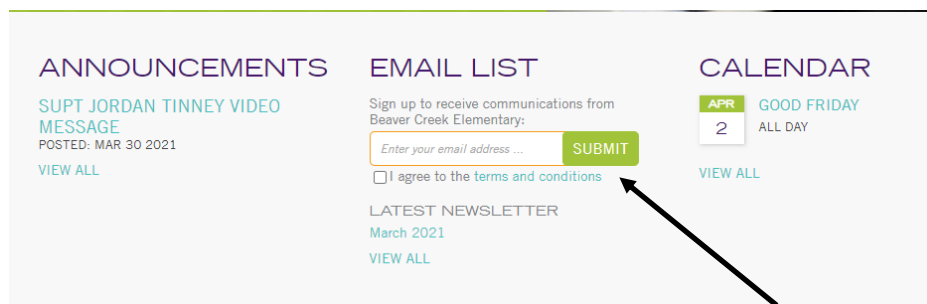

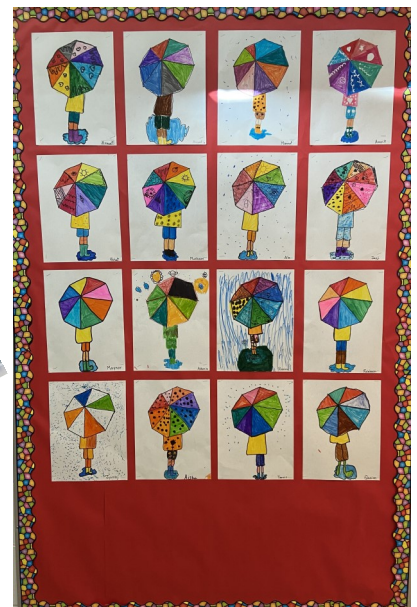
