

According to the <u>Federal Budget</u> released this week, there will be \$400.0 million in new funding over five years, starting in 2018–19, with \$88.4 million per year ongoing, in support of the Action Plan for Official Languages 2018-2023. One targeted component of this new funding will be to address the critical shortage of French teachers across Canada, an issue that CPF has had a strong voice on.

BC Family French Camp 2018


