If you plan on travelling please advise the office staff the dates you will be away. Thank you !



From government website: Unvaccinated and partially vaccinated youth 12 to 17 years of age are subject to the 14-day quarantine, and all testing requirements for pre-entry, arrival and Day-8 tests, whether or not they are accompanied by travellers who qualify as a fully vaccinated traveller.

# SCHOOL PARKING LOT

We are noticing that some parents/guardians are parking their cars in the drop off-pick up zone of the front parking lot to run their children to their Kindergarten or grade one class. We cannot have parents and guardians doing this as it stops the flow of traffic in and out of the parking lot. Please come a bit earlier and park your car in a designated parking spot in the parking lot or on the street where allowed and walk your child(ren) to the school. We appreciate your help keeping our parking lot moving smoothly and safely.

Thank you to all of the families who are dropping off and picking up properly at the front and the back of the school. We know that parking is very challenging around our school. Please make sure that you are following all signage at the front and the back of the school. Mme Niro contacted the City of Surrey last year to review the signage and to get clarification on what the signs mean. We appreciate everyone's help keeping our students safe.



This means that you cannot park here. You can do an <u>active</u> pick up or drop off. That means the student hops out of the car and you drive off <u>OR</u> student is waiting for you, you drive up, they get in and you drive off.



This means that you cannot stop, nor park in this zone at any time, for any reason.

#### Re: Sibling registration for Kindergarten September 2022

For the 2022-2023 school year, online kindergarten registration will start on January 10, 2022. Siblings (brothers & sisters) of students already attending an Early French Immersion school program get priority registration (starting December 1, 2021) for spaces in the same school.

Priority registration for siblings of current students starts December 1, 2021 and ends January 07, 2022. Due to COVID the registration process will be online again this year. On Tuesday December 01, we will start recording sibling requests via email for the 2022 Kindergarten program. Please email the school at Laronde@surreyschools.ca with the following information.

### **Documentation:**

### The following documents are required when registering:

- > Proof of birth date for the student Birth Certificate or Passport
- Proof of guardianship as shown on child's Birth Certificate, or other appropriate legal documentation such as Landed Immigrant Document or Guardianship Order
- Proof of citizenship for both the parent/guardian and student -Canadian Birth Certificate, Citizenship Card, Passport, Landed Immigrant Document, Permanent Resident Card, Enhanced Driver's License or Enhanced Identification Card
- Proof of residence of parent/guardian in BC:
- > BC Driver's license, BC Services Card, BCID or BC Care Card of parent/legal guardian; or
- A combination of other supporting documentation such as a Passport, Permanent Resident Card, ownership/long-term lease of dwelling, vehicle registration, employment within community, Canadian income tax record, etc.
- > Proof of student's living address purchase or rental agreement, utility bill, Driver's License, etc.

#### Documents which are helpful, but not required:

> Health Documents - Care Card, immunization records, medical condition information
