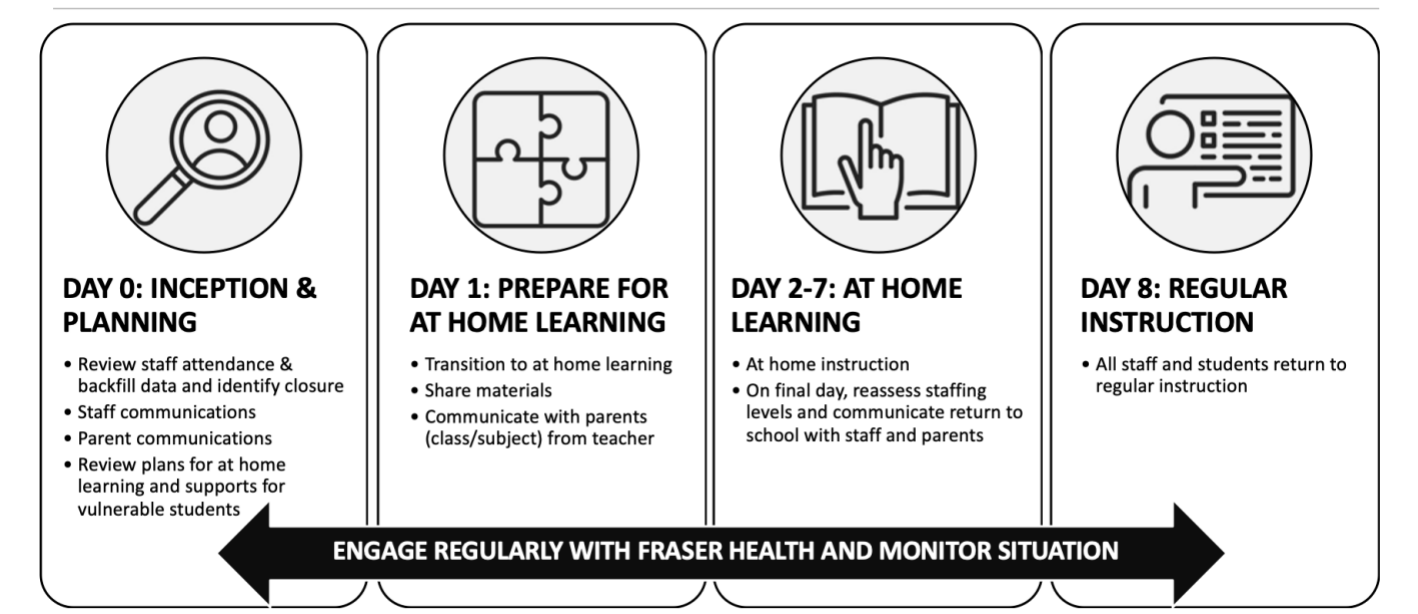


A few additions to our newsletter that went out today → Jan. 7, 2022:
