TIME CHANGE - SLEEP

With the fall time change drawing near (Sunday, November 1) we also wanted to remind families about the importance of sleep for students' social and emotional well being, health and learning. Attached is a chart that shows guidelines for the amount of sleep children need at different ages. If your child's sleep times are very different from those on the chart you may want to consider slowly changing times in 10-15 minute
