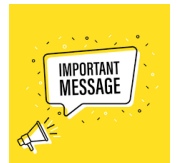

Important Information for Around Laronde



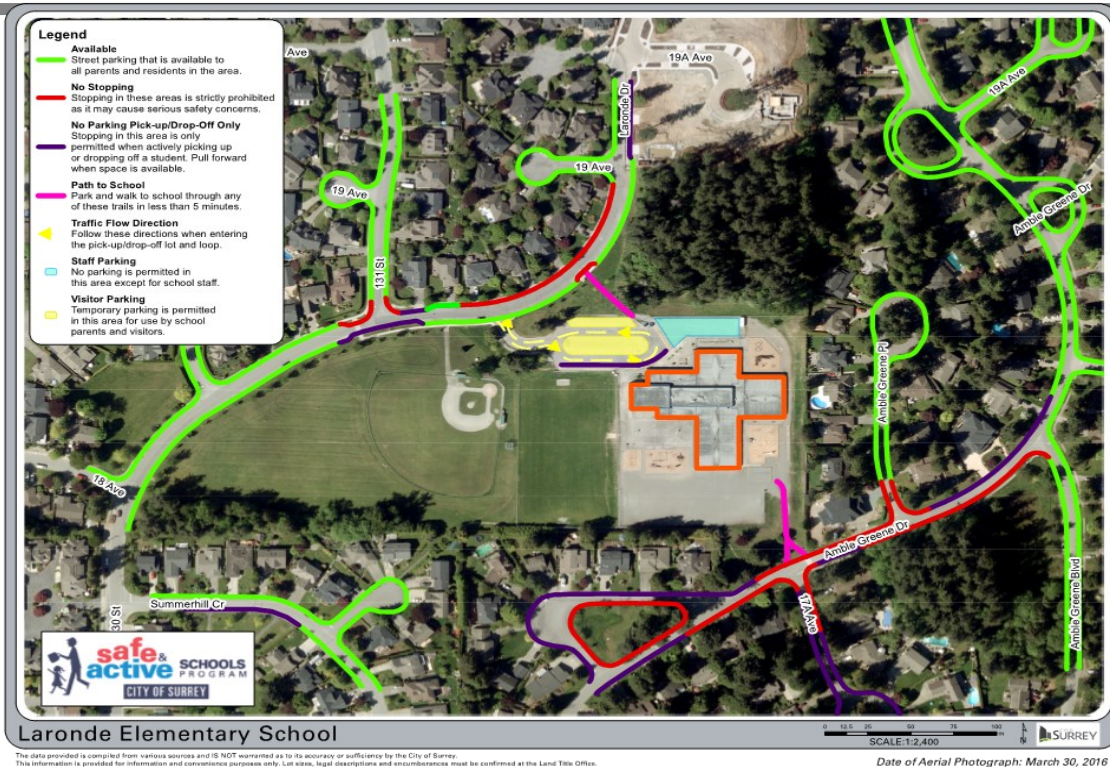
Forest - Please respect our forest. This is school district property, do not cut trees, do not break trees, no digging, supervise children, and respect neighbours fences.

Parking - respect neighbours driveways, please do not block their driveways, park in designated areas, bylaw does come by to ticket owners, see attached map of where you can park

School parking lot - we now have a new drive through lane, new centre sidewalk plus crosswalk to the school. The drop off and pick up zone is for driving up, dropping off and then continuing on into the drive through lane - please do not park in the drop off/pick up zone

No dogs/animals on school grounds - A friendly reminder that although we love animals here at Laronde they are **not permitted** on school district property, at any time. If you walk with a pet to school please ensure the pet is leashed and left off of school property.

The city of surrey has provided us with map that shows parking and no parking areas. Please review it carefully and be aware of the no parking zones around the school area.



Water bottles - Please remember to pack your child a water bottle.

Students and staff who become sick at school

⇒ If a student or staff member develops symptoms at school:

- They will be given a mask and separated from their classmates or colleagues. separated children will be supervised and cared for
- The student's parent or guardian will be contacted, and asked to have their child picked up as soon as possible (We know this can be challenging for parents/guardians who work and we encourage you to make plans with family and friends now for the possibility of one of your children being sick and unable to attend school.)
- Staff will be asked to go home as soon as possible
- Custodial staff will clean and disinfect the areas the person used

⇒ All students in grades 4- 12 and all adults must wear a mask indoors at all times except when eating, drinking or participating in very strenuous physical activity (please note that most PE activities are typically not considered very strenuous and teachers will take students outdoors as much as possible)

⇒ We will have all students and staff sanitize or wash their hands at the following times:

When Student Should Perform Hand Hygiene:	When Staff Should Perform Hand Hygiene:
When they arrive at school.	When they arrive at school.
Before and after any breaks (e.g., recess, lunch).	Before and after any breaks (e.g. recess, lunch).
Before and after eating and drinking (excluding drinks kept at a student's desk or locker).	Before and after eating and drinking.
Before and after using an indoor learning space used by multiple classes with shared equipment.	Before and after handling food or assisting students with eating.
After using the toilet.	Before and after giving medication to a student or self.
After sneezing or coughing into hands (students should be coughing into their elbow).	After using the toilet.
Whenever hands are visibly dirty.	After contact with body fluids (i.e., runny noses, spit, vomit, blood).
	After cleaning tasks.
	After removing gloves.
	After handling garbage.
	Whenever hands are visibly dirty.

⇒ We will attempt to maximize space between students by spacing out desks/tables and being mindful when doing group work and activities.

⇒ We will limit and keep track of the number of visitors coming in and out of the school. Please call or email before coming into the school.
