



Around Laronde – Sept. 2, 2020

Bienvenue – Welcome



We are very excited and happy to be starting this new school year with you! We know that this is a very different school year and we know that you may be hesitant, worried and that you may have lots of questions. We also know that some of you are very excited to be coming back to school and to seeing your friends and teachers again. We will be working together as a staff and community to keep each other safe, to ensure our students are learning and that we are still having some fun.

We wanted to outline the timeline for the first week of school Sept. 8 – 11, 2020.

- ⇒ Sept 8 & 9 will be a time for staff to review health & safety and start-up procedures as well as info on new procedures/ protocols to follow this fall and school year.
- ⇒ Sept 10 & 11 we will be gathering students at the school for one hour each day with various time slots. We will be doing this to ensure minimal contact with others before creating our new cohorts or learning groups. Each group will consist of one staff member and 10 students in the same grade. We know that some of you have children in different grade groups and we appreciate you bringing them at the time indicated on the chart.

We will ask families who can drop off their children to please do so and for those who want to or need to escort their children to their meeting area to please maintain 2 metres physical distance from all others, at all times. We need all persons to maintain this physical distancing for these two days as students will not yet be in their cohorts or learning groups. We ask that all parents remain outside the school building. We know that for some families this will be more difficult for you or your child. You can prepare your child (ren) in advance by letting them know it is only for a very short time, that you will remain on school grounds and that the teachers at Laronde love students. You can also show your child that they can trust us by showing trust towards the adult when you drop off your child (smile, make eye contact, say a warm hello).

Where to meet on Sept. 10 & 11?

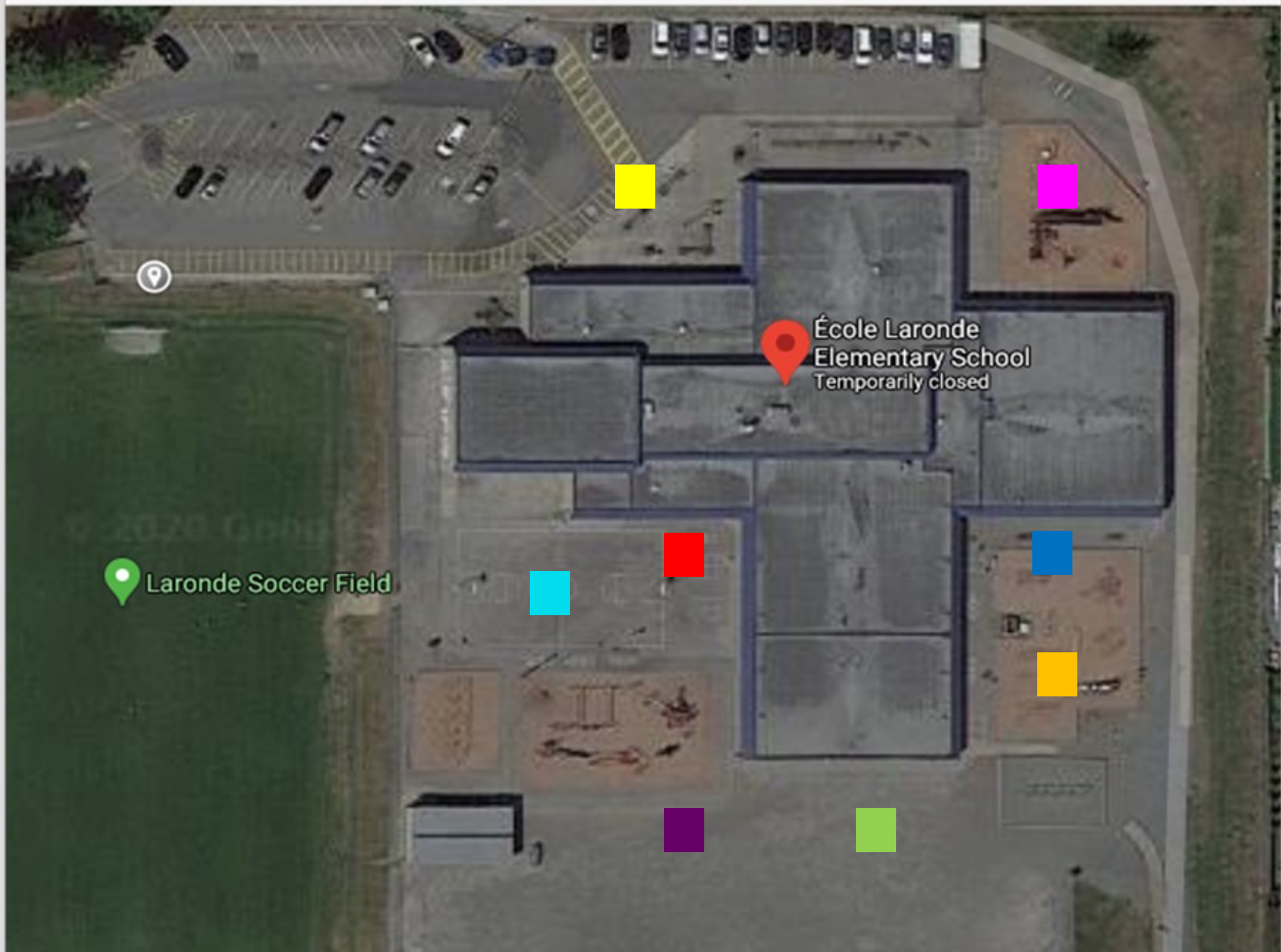
