FIRST DAY PROCEDURES:

Tuesday September 7, 2021 All students in grades 1-7 attend from 10:00 am - 11:00 am

Each grade will have two line-up cones. One cone for family last names A-K and one cone for family names for L-Z. Please have your child line up behind the appropriate cone.

See attached map for where to line up. Please try to maintain some distance between yourself and others.

Kindergarten families please follow the gradual entry timetable that was sent to you via email. Group A 10:00 am—10:30 am Group B 10:35—11:05 am

Parents can pick up their children from the same area where they dropped them off or by the cones where they lined up in the morning.

Teachers will let students know what basic school supplies to bring for the week.

All students in grades 1- 7 will attend full time starting Wednesday, September 8, 2021

Start time 8:35 (first bell)

End Time 2:40 (last bell)

Please line up in the same spots as the first day of school - same cones and same areas.





This online tool will determine whether you may need further assessment or testing for COVID-19. Available in English, Français, 中文(繁體), ਪੰਜਾਬੀ, 한국어, हिन्दी, العربية, فارسی, Tagalog, and Tiŋng Viŋt.

Students and staff who become sick at school

⇒ If a student or staff member develops symptoms at school:

- They will be given a mask and separated from their classmates or colleagues. separated children will be supervised and cared for
- The student's parent or guardian will be contacted, and asked to have their child picked up as soon as possible (We know this can be challenging for parents/guardians who work and we encourage you to make plans with family and friends now for the possibility of one of your children being sick and unable to attend school.)
- Staff will be asked to go home as soon as possible
- Custodial staff will clean and disinfect the areas the person used

⇒ All students in grades 4- 12 and all adults must wear a mask indoors at all times except when eating, drinking or participating in very strenuous physical activity (please note that most PE activities are typically not considered very strenuous and teachers will take students outdoors as much as possible)

⇒ We will have all students and staff sanitize or wash their hands at the following times:

When Student Should Perform Hand Hygiene:	When Staff Should Perform Hand Hygiene:
When they arrive at school.	When they arrive at school.
Before and after any breaks (e.g., recess, lunch).	Before and after any breaks (e.g. recess, lunch).
Before and after eating and drinking (excluding drinks kept at a student's desk or locker).	Before and after eating and drinking.
Before and after using an indoor learning space used by multiple classes with shared equipment.	Before and after handling food or assisting students with eating.
After using the toilet.	Before and after giving medication to a student or self.
After sneezing or coughing into hands (students should be coughing into their elbow).	After using the toilet.
Whenever hands are visibly dirty.	After contact with body fluids (i.e., runny noses, spit, vomit, blood).
	After cleaning tasks.
	After removing gloves.
	After handling garbage.
	Whenever hands are visibly dirty.

⇒ We will attempt to maximize space between students by spacing out desks/tables and being mindful when doing group work and activities.

⇒ We will limit and keep track of the number of visitors coming in and out of the school. Please call or email before coming into the school.
