Earlier today you would have received an email regarding the Surrey Blended: Elementary Transition Program. This program will provide an online learning option for our students but in order to organize and plan, parents and/or guardians **must register online for this program on or before September 8th**. Students who registered in the Surrey Blended program will not lose their space at Ocean Cliff Elementary. If you are not registering your child(ren) for the Surrey Blended: Elementary Transition Program the first day of school will be Thursday, September 10th. Students will attend on the following dates and times:

Thursday, September 10th & Friday September 11th

- Students in Grades 1, 2, 3, & 4 attend for 1 hour only from 9:00a.m. to 10:00a.m.
- Students in Grades 5, 6, & 7 attend for 1 hour only from 11:00a.m. to 12:00p.m.
- Kindergarten students will be divided into smaller learning groups for gradual entry. Additional information on the kindergarten gradual entry calendar will be email to families on Tuesday, September 1.

Monday, September 14th

- Students in Grades 1, 2, & 3 attend from 8:35 a.m. to 2:35 p.m.
- Students in Grades 4, 5, 6, & 7 attend from 9:05 a.m. to 2:35 p.m.

Tuesday, September 15th

- Students in Grades 1 to 7 from 8:35 a.m. to 2:35 p.m.

To maintain physical distancing on Thursday, September 10th and Friday September 11th students will be in small learning cohorts of approximately 10 students. Signs will be posted indicating where students should meet and wait for a teacher.

Next Thursday and Friday students will be reviewing health and safety protocols and routines. It is important for students to attend on these days to receive instruction on health and safety, and to confirm enrollment. Students will be placed into their learning cohorts (classes) for Monday, September 14th.
