II. Treasurer's Report


- I. PAC's account has a total balance of \$16,317.60

V. Principal's Report

- I. Librarian: New this year to the school, needs new items. PAC is giving \$200.00 towards library.

- V. Monster Mash: School here to help support. Quiet room to be used for colouring/activity sheets. Tables and chairs available for use.


4. Old Business
