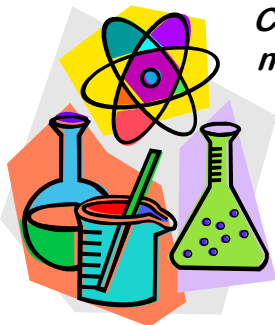


Chemistry 12

Chemistry is the science that deals with the properties and reactions of materials. It is concerned with the identification, characterization and transformations of matter along with the accompanying energy transformations.
