## 2023/2024 Partners36 Scholarships

### Coast Capital Beth Hutchinson Education Award

Surrey Schools is pleased to offer a number of scholarship and bursary opportunities to its graduates, called Partners36 Scholarships. These scholarships are made possible through the contributions of individuals, corporations and community service organizations.

The Coast Capital Beth Hutchinson Education Award recognizes a young person in Surrey who best exemplifies a commitment to continuing their education in the face of considerable health challenges. Beth was an inspirational 2021 Standing Tall winner from Surrey. Coast Capital is honouring her memory by making the Beth Hutchinson Award available to a student from her home community.

Students attending a district secondary school, a learning centre, SAIL or other District programs are eligible. See the general eligibility requirements below.

#### **Due Date**

Completed applications should be **submitted to the Scholarship Coordinator at your school** by the **due date designated by your school**. This is usually anytime between **February 15th and April 15th**. For more information and your school's due date, contact your school scholarship coordinator.

#### **General Eligibility Requirements**

1. Applicants must be a Canadian citizen or have Permanent Resident status.
2. The candidate must be a graduate of the Surrey School District.
3. In order to receive the funds the candidate must have plans to attend an accredited Canadian university, college or technical school in the 2023/24 school year.
4. For our purposes, "post- secondary institution" shall be defined as follows:
  - a. A recognized Canadian university
  - b. Canadian colleges offering transfer courses
  - c. Canadian institutions which prepare students for specific trades and vocations and which are recognized and supported by the government (eg. BCIT)
5. The candidate's academic achievement will be based on a review of an official transcript of the candidate's academic record for grades 11 and 12.
6. Scholarships are classed as earnings and reportable to CRA. Recipients of a scholarship will be required to provide their social insurance number, if they have not already done so, prior to receiving their award.
7. Please note winners name and application may be shared with Coast Capital and might be published in local newspapers subject to completion of a Media Release Form. Consent is optional.
8. The funds provided through the Coast Capital Beth Hutchinson Education Award is intended to be flexible and can be used, not only for tuition, but for other related expenses as well.
