<u>Code of Conduct</u> 2021 - 2022

In everything, and in every way, we want our students to be SHARP: Safe, Helpful, Accountable, Respectful & Positive

Port Kells school values are the foundation of our behavioural expectations.

Safe:

In order to demonstrate safety at our school:

- 1. Students will not make threats or behave violently.
- 2. Students may not possess weapons or bring replicas of weapons to school.
- 3. Students are expected to conduct themselves in a safe manner in order to ensure their own and others' safety while at work and play.
- 4. Students must comply with the law and show responsibility for their own health by never bringing any cigarettes, alcohol, or other illicit drugs to school.
- 5. Visitors must first sign in at the office and wear a badge while on school premises.

Helpful:

In order to foster a helpful, caring climate at our school:

- Students are expected to lend a hand to care for their school, school property and the property of others.
- 2. Students will clean up after themselves keeping the school and grounds clear of litter.
- 3. Students are expected to help others, showing caring and compassion for one another.

Accountable:

In order to demonstrate accountability for their actions at our school, students will tend to the following responsibilities:

- 1. Students are expected to attend school on a regular basis and in a timely manner. Students are expected to arrive on time. Parents are expected to contact the school in the event of absence.
 - eating lunch from 12:10 12:30, while sitting in the classroom.
 - Students are required to use the school playgrounds in a responsible manner (i.e. staying away from out of bounds areas - parking lots/front of school; walking bikes and scooters on school grounds - not riding.)
- 2. Students are expected to use the school grounds and play areas in a responsible manner (i.e. staying in designated areas; not playing in parking lots/front of school; walking bikes and scooters on grounds)
- 3. Students are expected to complete school assignments and ask for guidance from their teachers and/or parents when they need extra help.

Respectful:

In order to foster a respectful climate at our school,

- 1. Students will refrain from any behaviour that targets an individual or group for ridicule because of their differences.
- 2. With the wide variety of races and cultures in our community, students are encouraged to understand and respect the culture of others.
- 3. Student conduct will reflect respect for the working and learning conditions at school. Examples of this conduct include:
 - Moving quietly in hallways and speaking quietly in the school.
 - o Remaining calm and walking in the hallways.
 - o Taking off any hats or hoods indoors.
 - o Not chewing gum or bringing chewing gum on to the school grounds.
- 4. Students will dress appropriately for the school environment by adhering to dress code guidelines.

Positive:

In order to foster a positive climate at our school:

- 1. Students will encourage each other.
- 2. Students will give their best effort to try challenging tasks.
