Commencement Ceremony Procedures 2024

ON ARRIVAL AT BELL CENTRE/SULLIVAN HEIGHTS SECONDARY & REPORT TO THE STAFF AT THE FRONT DOOR.

1. Please note the following:

- PLEASE BE ON TIME.
- Do not bring purses or jackets as there is no place to put them.
- Bell Centre/Sullivan Heights Secondary and the grounds is a non-smoking area.
- Dress is semi-formal.
- Gowns and caps, with souvenir tassels and stoles are yours to keep.

2. Order of Entry:

- You will be placed in alphabetical order by a staff member. Please stay in alpha order!
- You will then be given instructions for the processional to the stage.

3. Stage Deportment:

- Students should not chew gum and maintain formal decorum. No phones out for the entire two hours.
- Your photograph will be taken by Artona while you are backstage. Each student will be provided with a complimentary picture these can be picked up at the school office in August at the same time as graduation diplomas if you have graduated by June 30th.

4. Acknowledging members of the Class of 2024:

- Student commencement write ups will be read as you cross the stage.
- Walk slowly, enjoy the moment, smile at your people.

5. Reminder:

- Please be prepared to sit on stage for two hours; you will be required to be seated on stage the entire time. Use the washroom before the ceremony begins.
- You will remain on stage until the final moment when you are instructed to do the hat toss, and then you may go meet up with your family in the plaza.
