Commencement Ceremony Procedures 2021

ON ARRIVAL AT GUILDFORD PARK, REPORT TO STAFF AT THE FRONT DOOR.

1. **Please note the following:**

- 1) PLEASE BE ON TIME.
- 2) **Do not bring purses or jackets as there is no place to put them.**
- 3) Guildford Park Secondary and the grounds is a non-smoking area.
- 4) Dress is semi-formal.
- 5) **Gowns and caps, with Souvenir Tassels and Vee Stoles are yours to keep.**

2. **Order of Entry:**

- You will be placed in alphabetical order by a staff member.
- You will then be given instructions for the processional to the stage.
- Once on the stage, **your family will have a moment to congratulate you.**

3. **Stage Deportment:**

- Students should not chew gum and maintain formal decorum.
- Your photograph will be taken by Artona while you and your family are on the stage. Each student will be provided with a complimentary picture – these can be picked up at the main office in August at the same time as graduation diplomas if you have graduated by June 30th.

4. **Acknowledging members of the Class of 2021:**

- As students cross the stage, we will be providing a statement about each student's accomplishments.

5. **Exit at the end of the Ceremony:**

- You will exit the school from the plaza.
- Once outside, please do not idle. We will need to keep the flow of people exiting the school consistent so that we can maintain physical distancing and not create an impromptu gathering.
