ASSAI (BC After School Sports and Arts Initiative)

\$138,000 will provide support to over 2,300 students, from across the district, in participating in sport- and art-based programs. These programs aim to help students develop skills that contribute to a healthy life through creative thinking and physical activity.

CANADIAN TIRE JUMPSTART

\$10,000 donated to the district's Summer Jumpstart Academy physical literacy program. The donation allows students at 5 elementary schools to participate in week long camps where students learn fundamental movement skills and the importance of healthy lifestyles.
