MUSICOUNTS - \$18,000

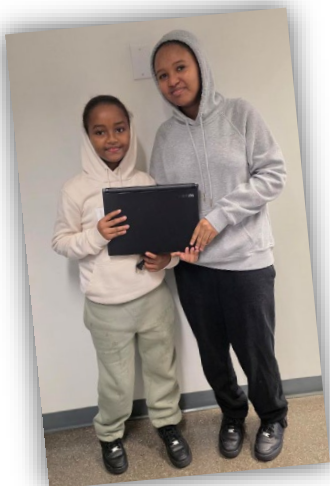
