- Develop connections to school and community supports and resources

- Develop communication and interpersonal skills
- Acquire volunteer opportunities for community involvement
- Develop leadership skills through training
- Increase skills in cross culture awareness
- · Improve interpersonal, communication and instructional skills and strategies
