Road Construction



From now until Winter Break, water main construction will be taking place along 70A Avenue and 123rd Street. In order to avoid traffic congestion, we encourage families to walk to school. There will be many changes to traffic flow during this time and the intersection at 70A Avenue and 123rd St. will also be significantly impacted.

A reminder that you *may not make* a *U-turn* on *70A Avenue* in front of the school and you *may not double park your vehicles*. There are many parking, traffic, and bylaw signs posted along the streets near the school. Please obey these signs at all times. No stopping and no parking means no stopping and no parking, even for a minute or two.

In addition, we have noticed that the crosswalk has been blocked a number of times and that parents are driving at excess speeds through the school zone. We will be working with RCMP and City of Surrey Bylaw to ensure that our students are kept safe during drop off and pick up.
