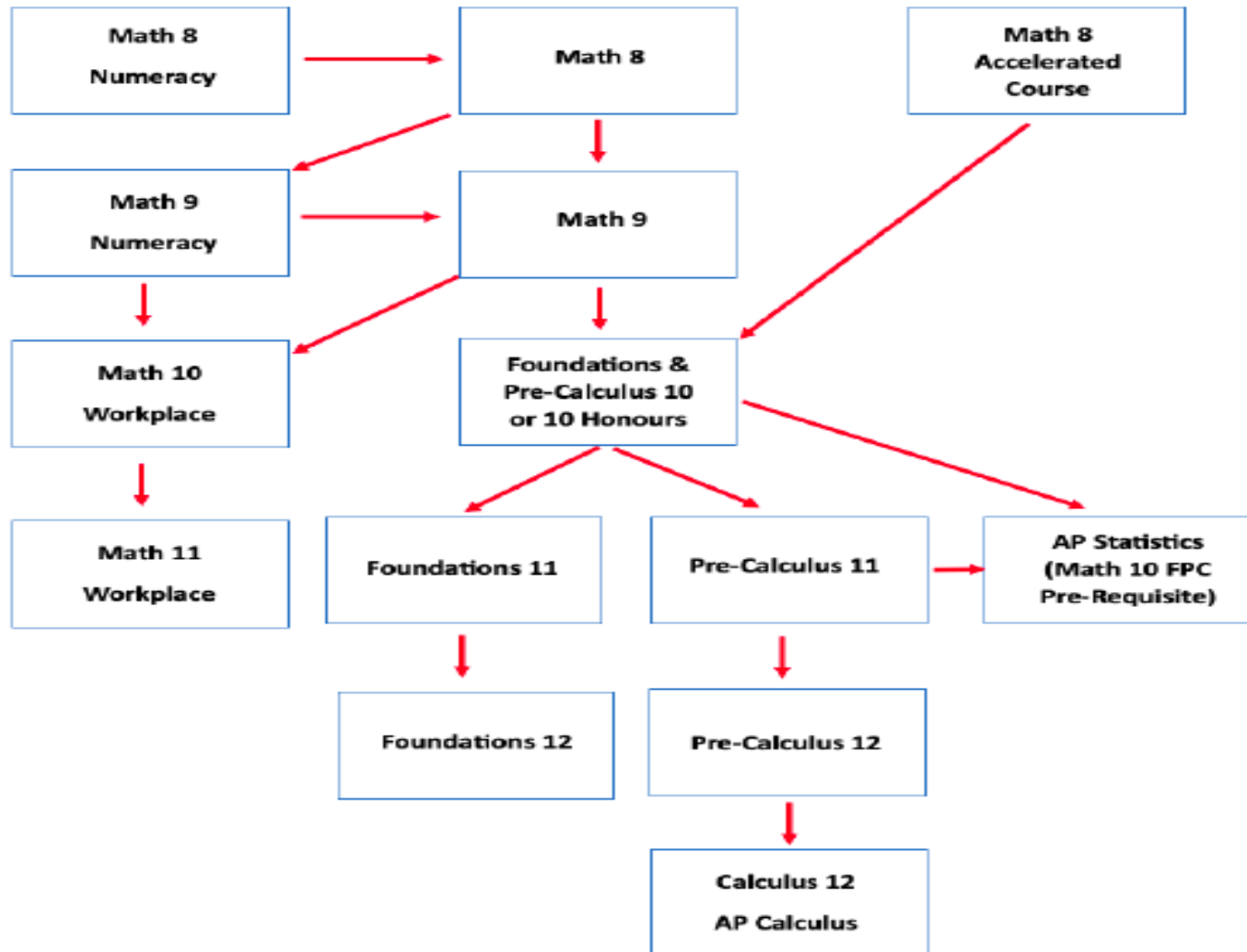

- A Second Study Block requires:
 - 5 Academic courses over the year.
 - A specific need.
 - Attendance and behaviour assessment.

 - (Surrey Continuing Education: 2 classes per week for 1 semester)


