## Who We Are – Film Making for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century

**Course: 8 credits**

**Rationale:** Multimedia careers are on the rise in British Columbia and students at Ecole Salish Secondary need a program to develop skills and experience the work environment to make educated decisions for the future.

### **Program Outline:**

- Course will be full day in the quarter system or half day in the semester system.
- Students will choose to focus in 2 streams from the following:
  - Media Arts – Video
  - Media Arts – Animation
  - Photography
- Students will practice and develop skills through small projects and will complete a final video project that defines WHO WE ARE.

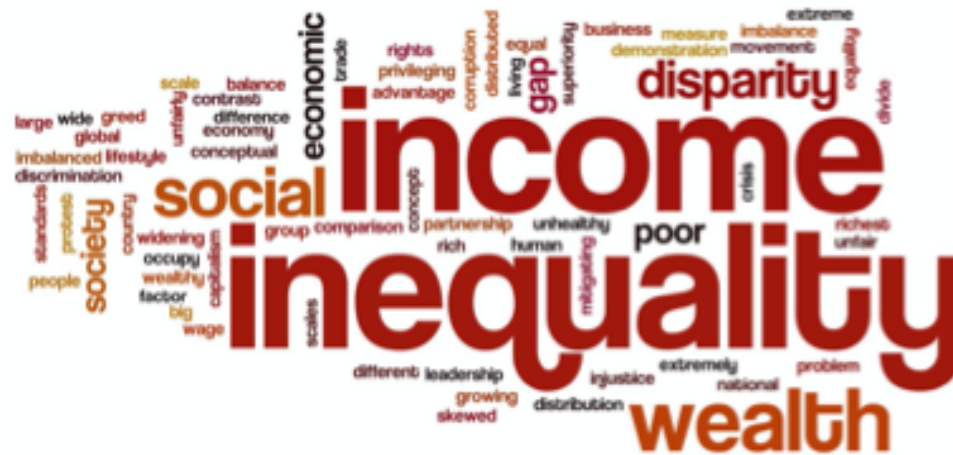
### **Highlights of the program:**

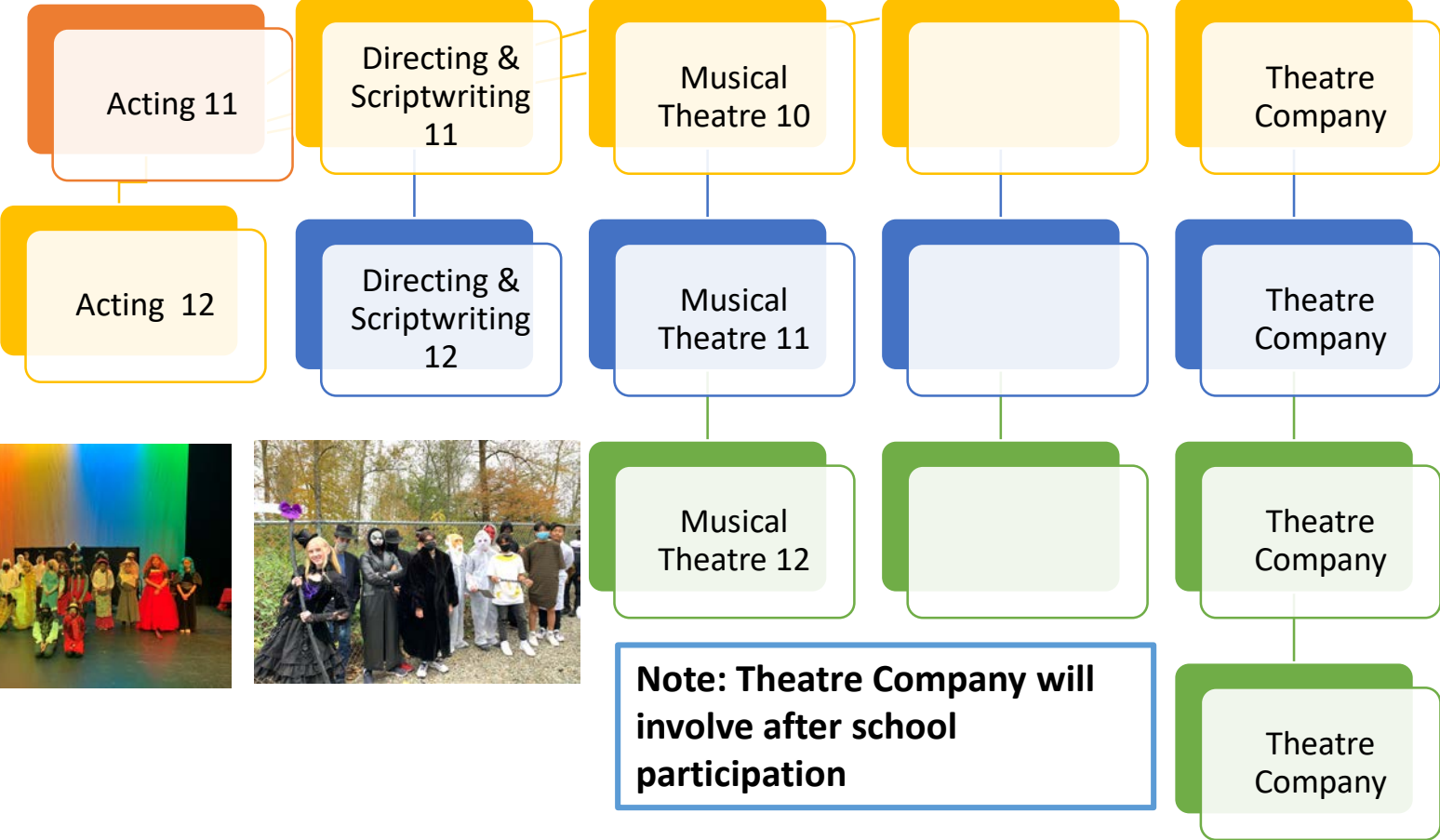
