Once again Kennedy Trail will be hosting PALS Sessions in the New Year. Dates and details can be found at the back of this newsletter. Please share this information with your neighbours.


Food Bank

Kindergarten Registration

Children who turn five-years-old before January 1, 2019 are eligible to begin school in September 2018. Kindergarten registration begins on Monday, Jan. 15, 2018. To register stop by the school to fill out a form or you can download it from our website. In order to register please bring:

- 1. Proof of birth date for the student (birth certificate or passport).
- 2. Proof of guardianship (as shown on child's birth certificate, or other appropriate legal documentation such as landed immigrant document or guardianship order).
- 3. Proof of citizenship for both the parent and student (Canadian birth certificate, citizenship card, passport, landed immigrant document, permanent resident card, enhanced driver's license or enhanced identification card).
- 4. Proof of residence (e.g., ordinarily resident) of parent/guardian in BC:
 - a. BC driver's license, BC Services Card, BCID or BC Care Card of parent/legal guardian; or
 - b. A combination of other supporting documentation such as ownership/long-term lease of dwelling, vehicle registration, employment within community, Canadian income tax record, etc.
- 5. Proof of living address (purchase or rental agreement, utility bill, driver's license, etc.)
